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TO OBTAIN COMPLETE INFORMATION FROM THESE TIME TABLES, OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING GENERAL RULES:

Time from 12.01 midnight to 12.00 noon (A.M. time) is shown in light figures; time from 12.01 noon to 12.00 midnight (P.M. time) is shown in **dark** figures.

In time tables where stations are in middle column, and time on BOTH sides, read the figures DOWN ON THE LEFT and UP ON THE RIGHT.

The time shown opposite a station name is the time trains are scheduled to be at such station. Where neither "Ar" nor "Lv" appears opposite a station name, the time of PASSENGER trains opposite such a station will be considered both the arriving and the leaving time.

Where no time is shown, trains do not stop.

The GENERAL and STATION INDEXES on pages 4, 6 and 7 are alphabetically arranged. The NUMBERS SHOWN IN STATION INDEX indicate TABLES, those in GENERAL INDEX indicate PAGES.

On the double-page map reproduced in this folder, numbers are shown at various points along the line. These numbers refer to tables where time of trains is given.

In many tables you will find pairs of ruled lines with one or more stations intervening. Such rules indicate that stations thus set apart are located on lines branching out from the line covered by the table. If your destination is on the main line of the table, and not on one of these branching lines, let your eye jump both rules in tracing your schedule.

ALL REFERENCE MARKS IN TIME TABLES SHOULD BE NOTED VERY CAREFULLY.

If You Are Planning a Trip Between Rock Island Points

look first at the map. Then find your starting point and your destination in the index and turn to the table whose reference number appears opposite both stations.

If a change en route is necessary, locate your junction point on the map; then turn to the table in which your starting point is shown and trace your schedule to that junction point. Opposite that junction point will be a number referring you to the table in which schedules to your destination will be given.

If more than one change is necessary, use table map reference numbers and STATION INDEX similarly to locate schedules between junction points.

THROUGH CAR SERVICE and EQUIPMENT TABLES A to Q, inclusive, contain complete information as to equipment of principal trains and will be of assistance in local as well as extended trips.

If You Are Planning a Trip Beyond Rock Island Terminals

examine first tables A to Q, to ascertain whether or not through service is available.

If there is no through service, follow instructions governing a local trip to obtain schedules as far as the Rock Island gateway; then turn to connecting line tables, pages 34 to 36, inclusive, for SCHEDULES via various lines from that gateway.

GENERAL INDEX

A FEW POINTERS IN REFERENCE TO THE TIME TABLES. STATION INDEX, ALPHABETICALLY ARRANGED, is on pages 6 and 7. Index below provides convenient reference to location of through service tables, important traffic centers and to branch lines.

In time tables where stations are in middle column and time on both sides, read the figures down on the left and up on the right.

The time shown opposite a station name is the time the trains are scheduled to be at such station. When neither "Ar." nor "Lv." appears opposite a station name, the time of passenger trains opposite such a station will be considered as both the arriving and the leaving time.

Principal stations are shown in dark-faced type. Where no time is shown, trains do not stop.

A. M. time is shown in light figures; P. M. time in dark figures.

Note all reference marks very carefully.

GENERAL INFORMATION

NOT RESPONSIBLE—No responsibility is assumed for errors in time tables, inconvenience or damage resulting from delayed trains or failure to make connections; schedules herein are subject to change without notice.

BUY TICKETS before boarding trains and avoid payment of extra charge.

ADJUSTMENT OF FARES—In cases of dispute with Conductors or Agents, pay the fare required, take receipt and communicate with Passenger Traffic Manager.

STANDARD OF TIME—C. R. I. & P. trains east of Phillipsburg, Kans., and Tucumcari, N. M., are run by Central Time; west of Phillipsburg, Kans., and Tucumcari, N. M., by Mountain Time.

MILEAGE—The mileage stated in time tables is shown in full figures for the information of passengers only and is not to be used in computing fares.

REDEMPTION OF TICKETS—Applications for redemption of unused portion of tickets should be made to Mr. L. M. Allen, Vice President and Passenger Traffic Manager, Rock Island Lines, Room 723 La Salle Station, Chicago, Ill. The unused portion of tickets issued by other roads should be sent to General Passenger Agent of issuing road.

TICKETS MUST BE USED WITHIN LIMIT—Local one way tickets will be honored only for continuous passage to destination, commencing within one day from date of sale. Passengers holding Interline Tickets must reach destination not later than midnight of date punched or indicated on stopover pasteur.

CHILDREN who are not five years old are carried free when accompanied by parents or guardians. Those who have reached or passed their fifth birthday and are under twelve years of age, require a half ticket. Those who have reached or passed their twelfth birthday require a full ticket. Conductors are not allowed to vary from this rule.

LOST ARTICLES are in charge of General Baggage Agent at Chicago; passengers who have lost articles on trains or at stations will please communicate with him direct or through their nearest Ticket Agent. Articles lost in Pullman cars, if found, are returned to that company, and report of loss should be made direct to Pullman Company.

BAGGAGE—150 pounds of baggage will be carried free on each whole ticket and 75 pounds on each half ticket.

Clergymen, etc., presenting half tickets together with half-fare permits, are allowed 150 pounds of baggage free.

Passengers holding tickets for trans-Pacific points (China, Japan, etc.) will be allowed 350 pounds of baggage on each whole ticket, and 175 pounds on each half ticket.

Baggage in excess of the above allowances will be charged for at rates published in current Tariffs of the first-class limited ticket rate per 100 pounds.

Passengers have privilege of declaring excess value on baggage at the time of checking at a charge of 10 cents for each additional \$100.00 or fraction thereof. Limit of excess for one passenger \$2500.00.

Excess value stamps equivalent to the amount paid will be attached to the back of duplicate check.

Any one piece of baggage the greatest dimension of which exceeds seventy-two (72) inches (except whips in cases and public entertainment paraphernalia, etc.) or weighing over 250 pounds (except immigrant baggage) will not be checked, but must be sent by express or freight.

Baggage for Alaska or trans-Pacific points will not be checked beyond point where land journey ends.

This Company does not guarantee to forward baggage on same train with passenger or within a given or specified time limit; it reserves the right to forward baggage on same train with passenger or upon a preceding or following train, as the exigencies of each case may require.

Every effort will be made to check and forward baggage on same train with passenger, baggage facilities thereon permitting, except that when baggage is not delivered at station in sufficient time to be properly weighed and necessary collection made, it will be forwarded on first convenient train C. O. D., for any charges.

In order to provide greater facilities for transportation of passengers, this Company has placed motor cars in service between certain points. Owing to limited space provided for baggage, the Company does not guarantee transportation of baggage in these cars and will not be responsible for any delay by reason of failure to handle baggage therein.

It is unlawful for the railroad to transport baggage containing fireworks or other like explosives and dangerous articles.

Hand baggage in Pullman Cars is restricted to what can be conveniently placed in the berth, seat or other accommodations purchased by the passenger.

For the passenger's own protection all baggage to be checked should bear owner's name and address in a substantial and legible manner, as the absence of such means of identification frequently results in delay and sometimes in loss of baggage, with the consequent annoyance, inconvenience and expense to the owner as well as to the carrier.

AUTOMATIC COIN-CONTROLLED STEEL PARCEL CHECKING LOCKERS are installed in station waiting-rooms at important points on the C. R. I. & P. Ry. Patrons desiring to check their grips, parcels or hand baggage select a vacant locker, indicated by the key in the lock, and after placing the baggage inside drop a dime in the slot, turn the key to the right, and upon withdrawing the key it leaves the parcel locked and checked, the key representing the check inasmuch as it is numbered to correspond with the compartment occupied.

BABY CABS AND GO CARTS are checked at rate charged for 50 pounds excess baggage unless that weight is exceeded, in which case actual gross weight will be charged for.

DOGS transported on passenger trains must be checked and handled in baggage service subject to tariff rules. Minimum charge for each dog in crate same as for fifty pounds of excess baggage; otherwise on leash and muzzled, subject to charge same as for one hundred pounds of excess baggage.

OTHER DOMESTIC PETS such as cats, birds, etc., may be handled in baggage service subject to tariff rules when in crates or cages. Minimum charge same as for fifty pounds of excess baggage.

BICYCLES AND TRICYCLES when in trunks will be included in weight and value of passenger's baggage. When not in trunks they will be checked at rate charged for 50 pounds excess baggage unless that weight is exceeded, in which case actual gross weight will be charged for.

FOR CORPSE—The rate for the transportation of a corpse, regardless of the age of the deceased, will be one regular lowest first-class adult fare, with minimum fare as prescribed in tariff, when accompanied by an adult in charge who must hold transportation. 150 pounds of baggage is allowed on each corpse ticket.

An adult corpse can be forwarded by express at double the regular first-class ticket rate, and that of a child under twelve years of age at one regular first-class ticket rate. When a corpse is shipped by express, no attendant or accompanying person is necessary. No ticket will be issued for a corpse through New York City.

TRAINS usually run on time, in accordance with time tables given herein, but the Company will not be responsible for consequences arising from delays, or from errors in the printed schedules.

REPRESENTATIVES OF NATIONAL TRAVELERS AID SOCIETY are at the La Salle Street Station, Chicago, at Des Moines and Cedar Rapids stations, for the purpose of relief of distress and assistance of unprotected. Those in need of such service should inquire of the station force for a National Travelers Aid Society representative.

OPTIONAL ROUTE VIA SAN DIEGO

Arrangements are in effect for the application of fares and sale of tickets (one-way and round-trip), via El Centro and San Diego; however, this representation has not been inserted in all joint tariffs and in order to permit holders of tickets, who may desire to travel via El Centro and San Diego, optional route arrangements are authorized by exchange of tickets, under certain conditions which may be obtained from agents.

ROUND-TRIP TICKETS TO SAN FRANCISCO, OAKLAND, CAL., PORTLAND, ORE., TACOMA AND SEATTLE, WASH.

1. Where ticket reads in both directions via El Paso or Tucson—

(a) Westbound coupons over S. P. Lines will be exchanged by S. P. Lines Agent at Yuma, or by conductor on the train from Yuma to San Diego via Calexico and El Centro, for a ticket with the necessary coupons good for passage from Yuma to San Diego via Calexico, El Centro and the S. D. & A. Ry., thence via A. T. & S. F. Ry. to Los Angeles, **no additional charge to be made.**

(b) Eastbound coupons over S. P. Lines will be exchanged by the Agent of the A. T. & S. F. Ry. at Los Angeles, **no additional charge to be made.**

2. Where ticket reads in one direction via El Paso or Tucson and in the other direction via Los Angeles and Albuquerque or Salt Lake City; or via Barstow and Albuquerque, or via S. P. Lines and Ogden, or via The Western Pacific Railroad Company and Salt Lake City, or via Portland—

(a) Westbound coupons over the S. P. Lines will be exchanged by S. P. Lines Agent at Yuma, Ariz., or by the conductor of the train from Yuma to San Diego, as explained above in paragraph 1a, at an **additional charge of \$9.00** to be made on each All Year Tourist ticket and \$7.50 on each Summer Tourist ticket.

(b) Eastbound coupons over S. P. Lines will be exchanged by the Agent of the A. T. & S. F. Ry. at Los Angeles, at an **additional charge of \$9.00** to be made on each All Year Tourist ticket and \$7.50 on each Summer Tourist ticket.

3. Southern Pacific coupons of round-trip tickets, destined to Los Angeles (not routed via San Francisco), reading in both directions via El Paso or Tucson, or in one direction via El Paso or Tucson and in the other via direct route to Salt Lake City, may be exchanged, **without additional charge**, to read via El Centro, S. D. & A. San Diego, A. T. & S. F. Los Angeles. Exchange may be made in same manner as outlined above in connection with tickets destined to San Francisco.

ARRANGEMENTS FOR TICKETING VIA SOUTHERN PACIFIC TO POINTS IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA ON PACIFIC ELECTRIC RY.

The Southern Pacific Company (Pacific System) has an arrangement with the Pacific Electric Ry., whereby tickets may be sold reading via Southern Pacific (Pacific System) to a limited number of destinations reached by the Pacific Electric. Under this arrangement tickets reading via Southern Pacific thru to destination are honored via Southern Pacific to Colton, Ontario, Pomona or Los Angeles, according to location of destination, passengers being provided by Southern Pacific conductors with exchange checks good for passage on Pacific Electric Ry., from proper junction points (Colton, Ontario, Pomona or Los Angeles as the case may be) to destination.

HONORING ARRANGEMENTS VIA C. R. I. & P. RY.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago, Kansas City and beyond will be honored via direct line through Washington, Ia., or via Des Moines, Ia.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago, St. Louis, Kansas City, St. Joseph, Omaha and stations east and Tucumcari, N. M., and points beyond will be honored via Texhoma or Texola, Okla.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago or Peoria and Denver or Colorado Springs and beyond, will be honored via Council Bluffs, Omaha, St. Joseph or Kansas City.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago, St. Louis, Kansas City, St. Joseph, Omaha or stations east and California, routed via El Paso or Tucson will also be honored, southbound, to Wichita and from Hutchinson, Kansas; northbound, to Hutchinson and from Wichita, Kansas. In either case passenger must pay fare and make own arrangements between Wichita and Hutchinson, Kansas.

Round trip tickets good for passage between Chicago, St. Louis, Kansas City, St. Joseph, Omaha or stations east and Fort Worth or Amarillo and points beyond will be honored via Oklahoma City if desired.

Numerous other optional, diverse and honoring arrangements are also available.

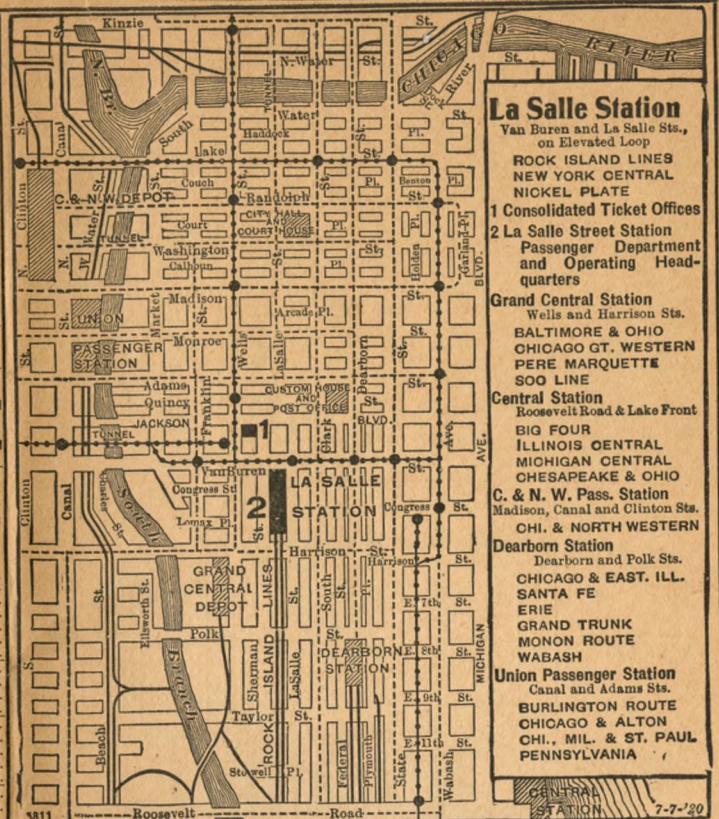

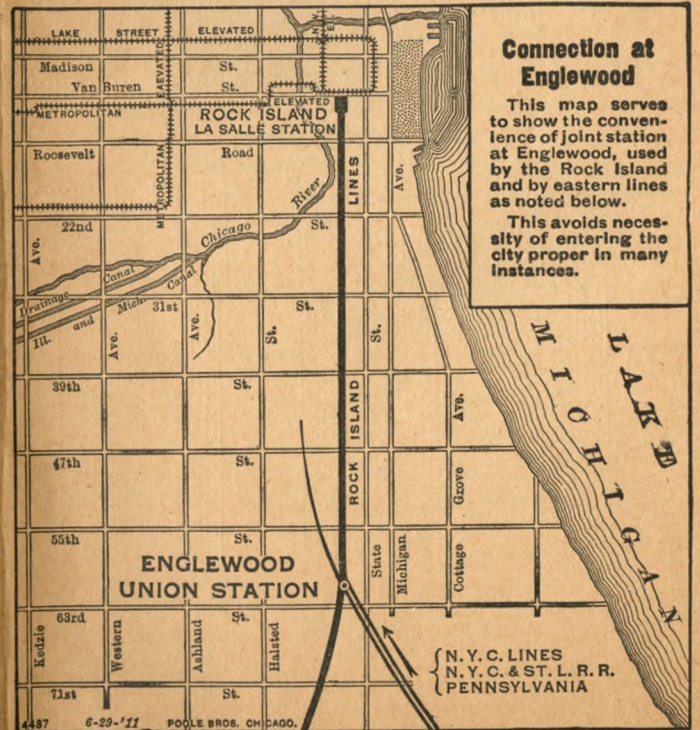
