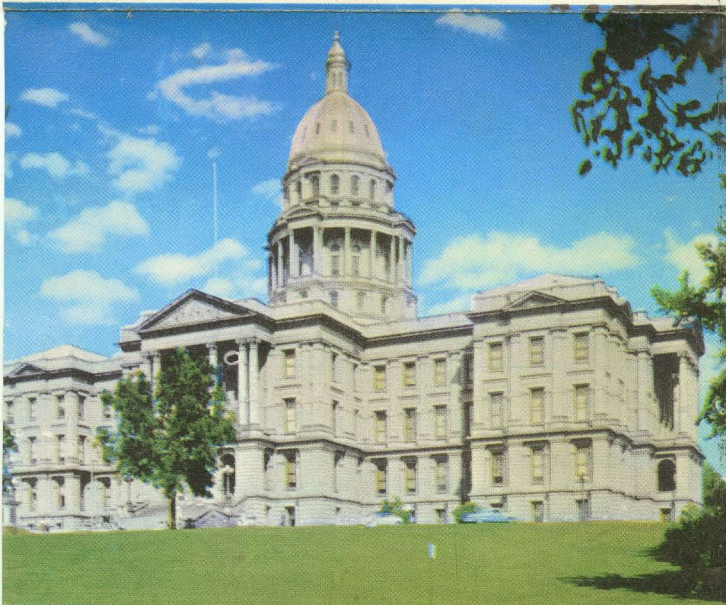
BAGGAGE A substantial suit case or bag should hold enough clothes for the trip.

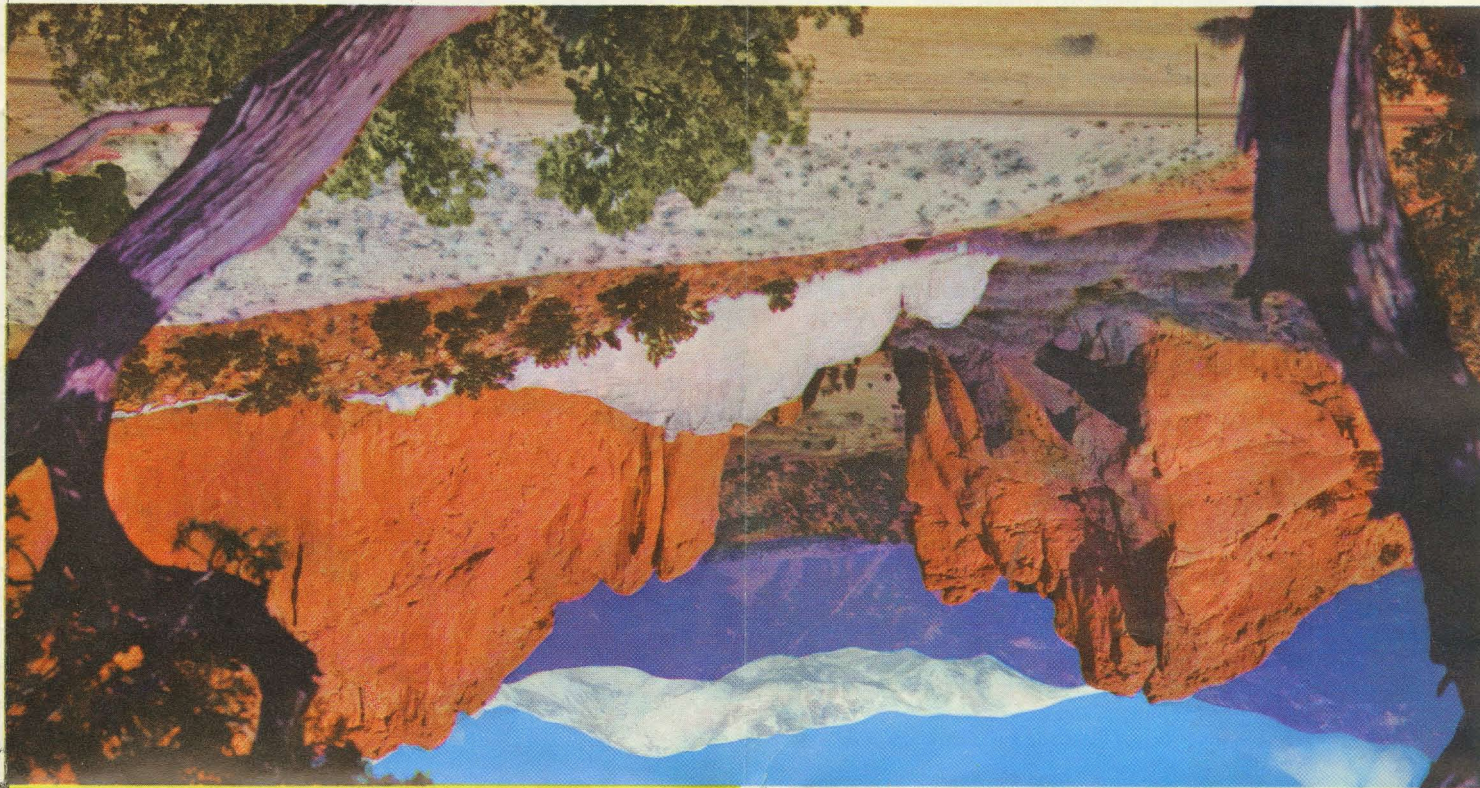

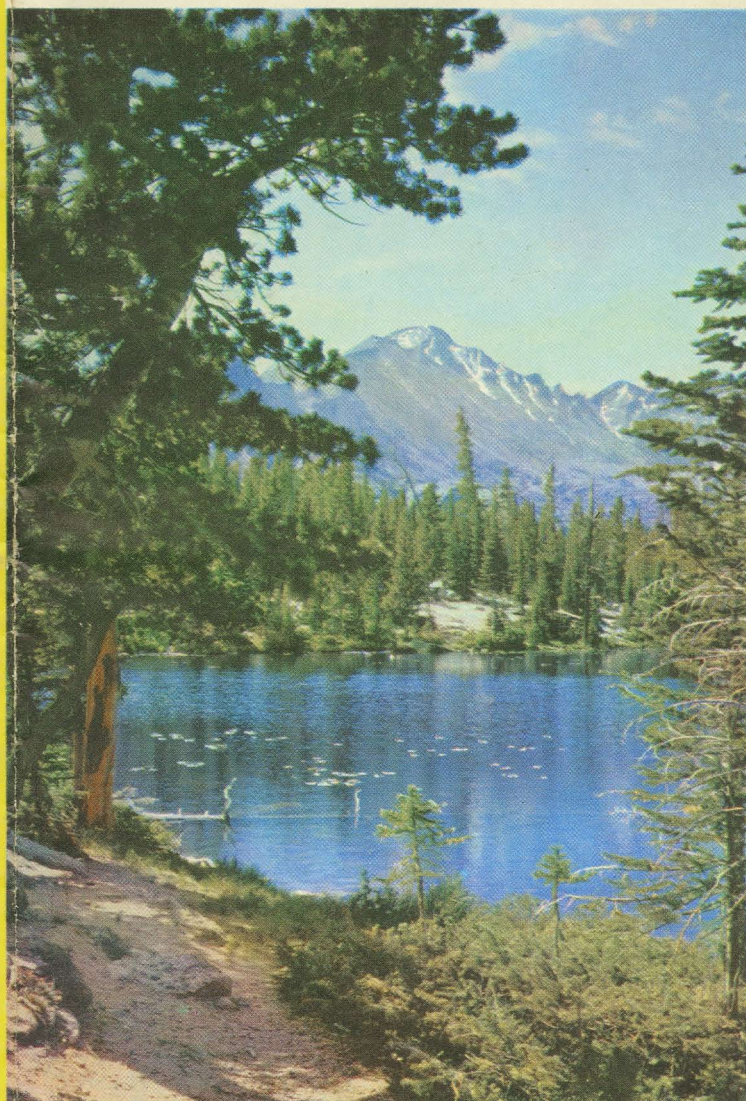

SECOND DAY Arrive Denver Union Station early morning. At 9:15 a.m. leave same station by Rocky Mountain Motor coach for the first part of the "Grand Circle" tour of Estes-Rocky Mountain National Park, traveling northward from Denver through a grain and fruit raising district, thence along the snow-capped "Front Range" and west through stupendous Big Thompson Canyon with its towering walls and unusual rock formations. 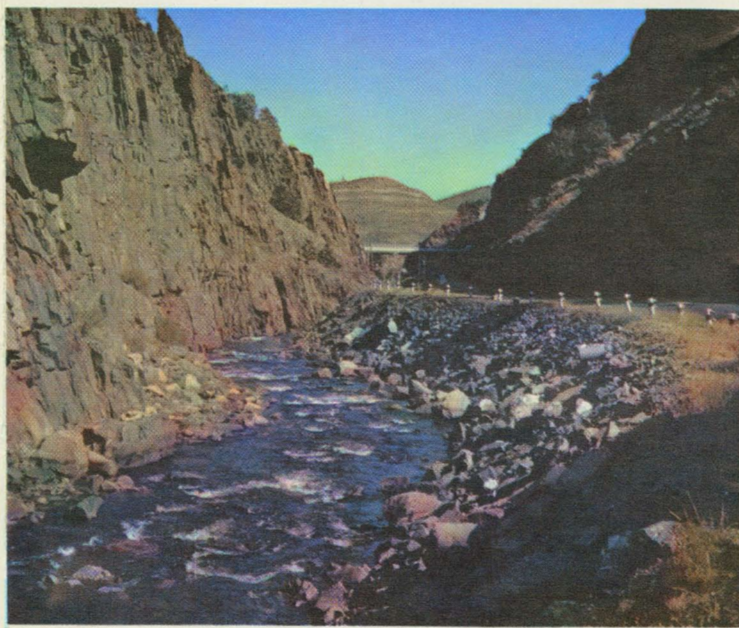
