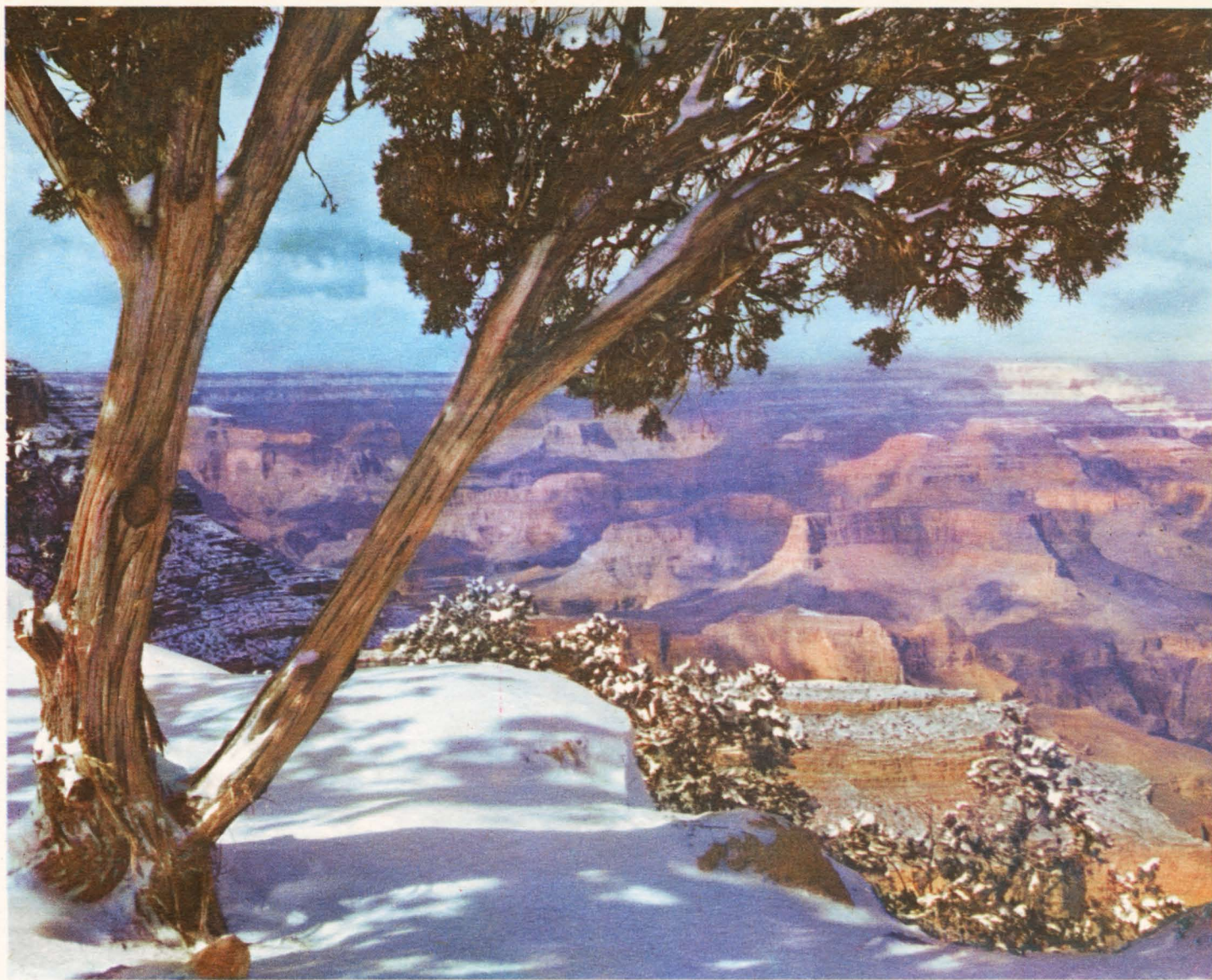

What has perhaps received more publicity than all this and even the Canyon itself, are the famous inner-Canyon trail trips on muleback—to Plateau Point or to the Colorado River and on to Phantom Ranch, a unique Fred Harvey guest ranch in the bottom of the Canyon. In recent years, off-season visits to the Grand Canyon have become increasingly popular, as more and more tourists and managers of travel groups and conventions realize the advantage of uncrowded facilities and leisurely enjoyment of the Great Chasm. The famous Canyon colors are even more spectacular in fall, winter and spring, and the Grand Canyon clothed in bright new powder snow is a sight never to be forgotten.

Fred Harvey operations at Grand Canyon are among the largest enterprises of the company. As main concessionaire of the National Park Service on the South Rim, Fred Harvey operates hotels and cabins, sightseeing trips, a bus line (Grand Canyon-Williams) and a number of supplementary facilities serving hundreds of thousands of tourists every year. El Tovar Hotel, a spacious structure of rustic pine logs, is perhaps the best-known of these establishments. However, the newer Bright Angel Lodge and Cabins and the Grand Canyon Auto Cabins are of no lesser importance. A number of curio shops, of which the Hopi House and the Trading Post are the largest and most interesting, are also Fred Harvey operated. A fleet of new Harvey motor coaches serves the popular conducted Rim Drives—west to Hermit's Rest, east
