The costume of most of the Pueblo Indians is in a degree picturesque. Although the men of the Pueblos have almost entirely given up the old native costume, the women still cling to the black native made dresses which have been worn for hundreds of years while on their feet they wear a moccasin of buckskin which terminates in a long broad strip which is wound many times about the lower leg.
