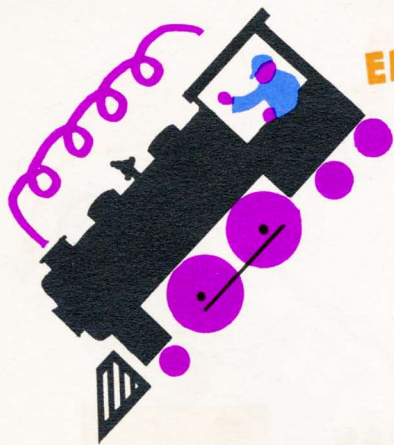

BRAKEMAN

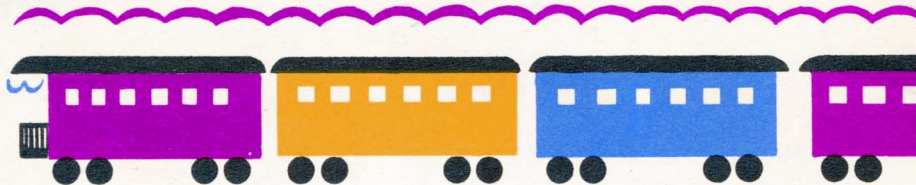
The brakeman with his flags and lights

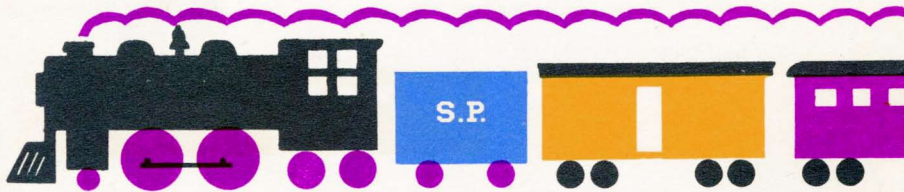

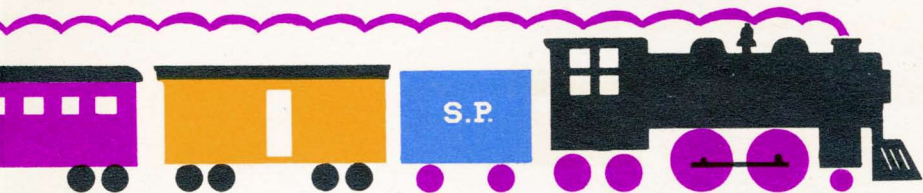

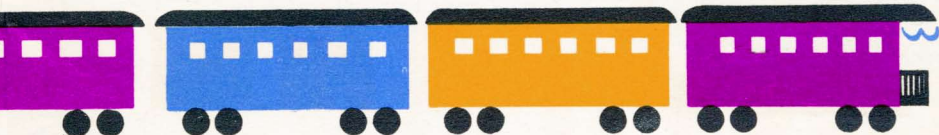

So he can sell his food to us.

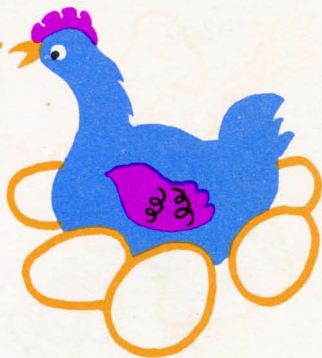


SUSIE
