Please read this little folder carefully. It contains information important to you for your commuting convenience.

San Francisco Peninsula Commuting Zones

To determine your commuting zone, pick out the station from which you commute regularly (not necessarily the city in which you live). Your "zone" is shown opposite that station by number and color.

PENINSULA ZONE FARES

To determine your fare, simply select the zone from which you will commute regularly (remember, you can ride to or from all stations in that zone). Read to right under the type of ticket you prefer to use. This figure is your Zone Fare. You may ask for your ticket by zone and color.

HERE'S HOW SIMPLE AND CONVENIENT THE NEW ZONE SYSTEM IS!

Zone Fares will become effective November 11, 1957.

Monthly commutation tickets for the month of November will be honored and handled as usual to the end of the month.

Weekly, 20-Ride Family, One Way and Round Trip single ride tickets purchased on or after November 11, 1957, will be new Zone Fare tickets. (See illustrations on back of this folder.)

During the balance of November all tickets, both old style and new Zone Fare tickets, will be punched as required and "hat-checks" issued.

We are installing ticket holders and additional "hatcheck" clips in seat-backs which will be for your use in displaying your ticket starting December 1, 1957.

On and after December 1, all you need do is remember these three simple steps:

DISPLAY YOUR TICKET AS SOON AS YOU TAKE YOUR SEAT.

Lower deck seats in double-deck cars, and seats in single-deck cars . . . use "hat-check" clips at top of seat-back in front of you.

Upper deck seats in double-deck cars... use the plastic ticket holder on panel above center aisle beside your seat.

End seats on lower deck of double-deck and single-deck cars . . use clips on wall above heads and on side wall above window.

2 LEAVE YOUR TICKET ON DISPLAY ALL THE TIME YOU ARE RIDING SO CONDUCTOR MAY SEE IT WHEN CHECKING TRAIN.

TAKE YOUR TICKET WHEN YOU LEAVE.

Please print your name, address and telephone number on the back of your ticket as soon as you buy it to protect yourself in case ticket is mislaid.

Examples of new Zone Fare tickets

for Blue Zone 4. Tickets for other zones will be similar except for color which designates zone for which it is purchased.



Monthly Commute (except Sat. & Sun.) Conductors will not punch this ticket. It is good for as many trips a day Monday through Friday as desired.

Monthly Commute (every day). Conductors will not punch this ticket. It is good for as many trips a day as desired.





Weekly Commute. Conductors will not punch this ticket. It is good for as many trips a day as desired.

20-Ride Family Ticket. Conductors will punch this ticket. It may be used by any member of the family for a combined total of 20 trips between zone stations and San Francisco on any day of the week.





One-Way ticket. Conductors will punch this ticket. Round-Trip ticket is similar but with letter "R" and a broken border in color of zone.

Tickets for travel between local peninsula stations and Student tickets are also available. Ask your Agent for further details.
