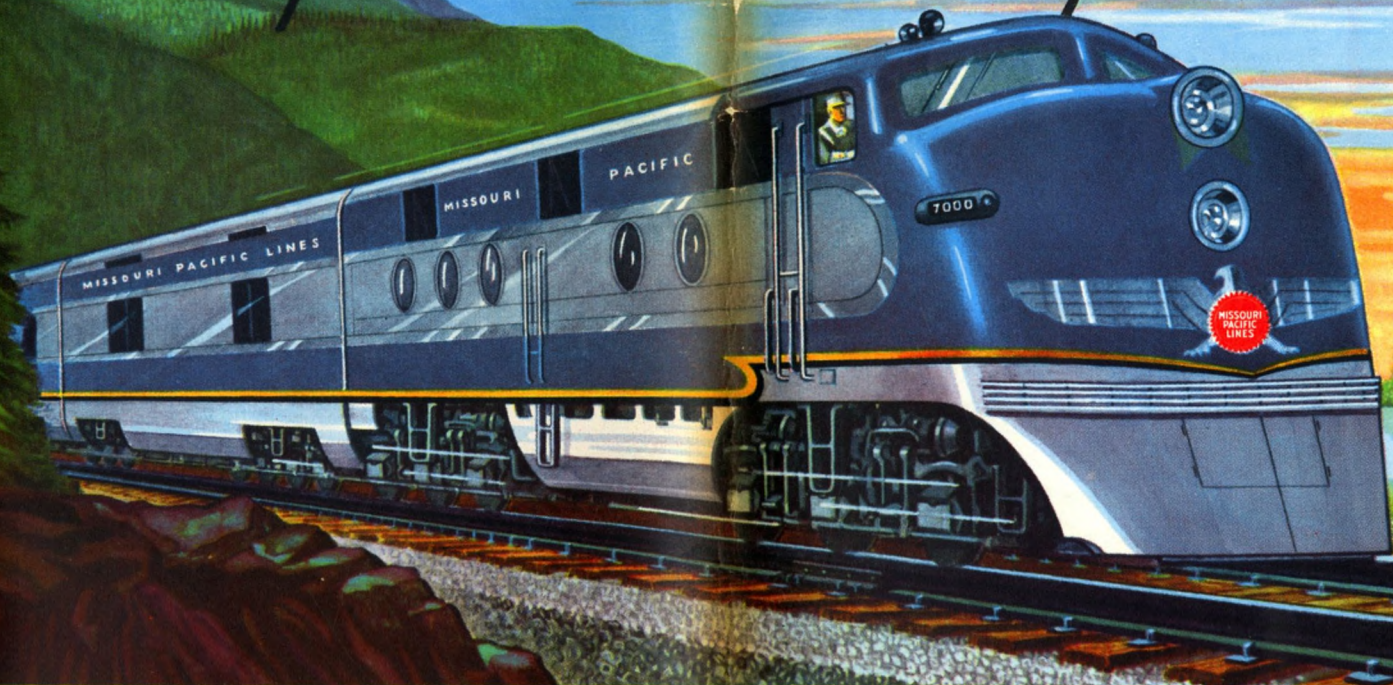

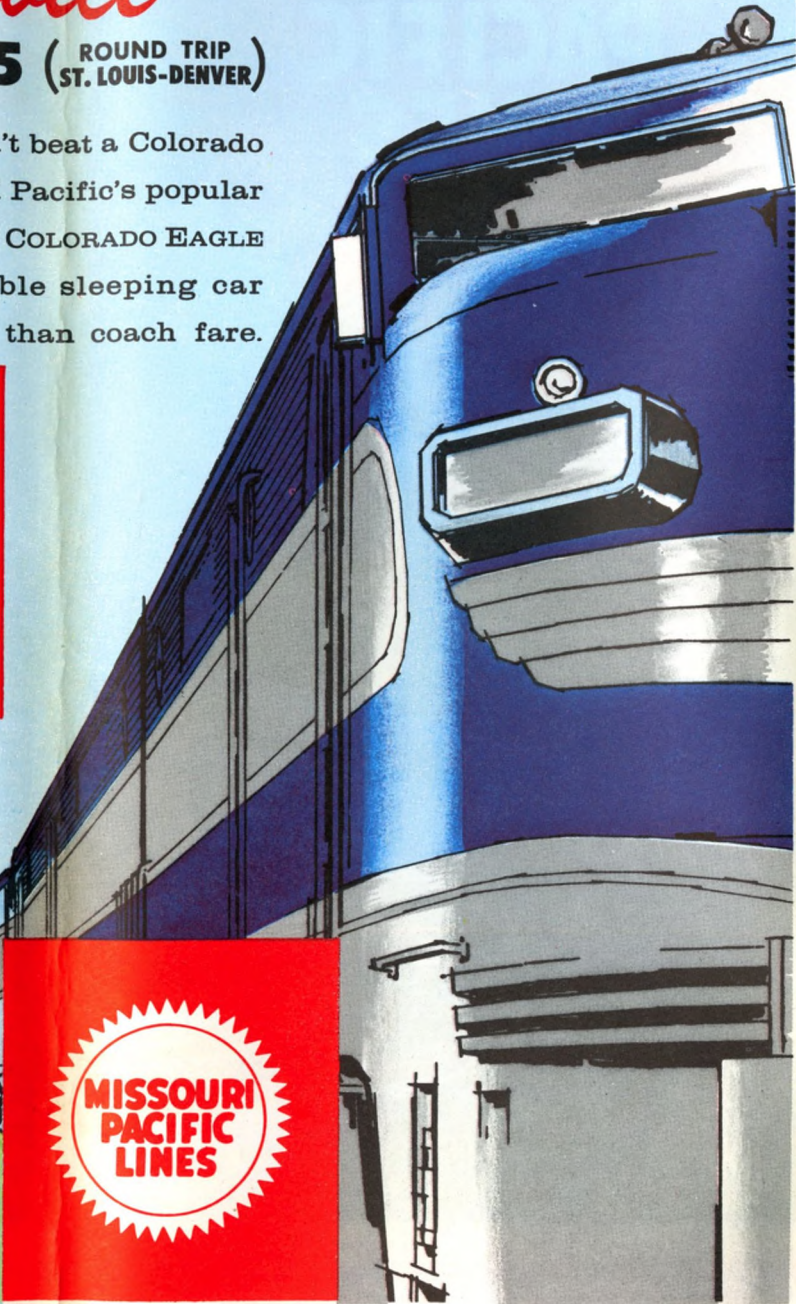
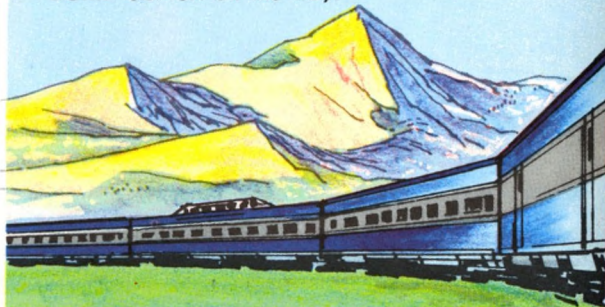

Each symbol is explained in a footnote on the page on which it is shown. If you encounter a symbol in the table you are consulting, be sure to check the footnote. The information may affect your travel plans.

That TRAVEL TAX Should be REPEALED

Because . . . it continues to discourage use of public carriers at a time when the need is for policies that encourage public carrier use.

Because . . . the future of railroad passenger service, which in World War II was relied upon for 97 per cent of all organized military travel needs and would be equally vital in another war, is today threatened by operating deficits of over \$700 million a year.

Because . . . by weakening our essential public carriers the tax undermines our national defense.

Because . . . the tax adds over \$200 million a year to transportation cost.

Because . . . to the extent that it applies to business travel and is therefore reflected in commodity prices, the tax is inflationary.

Because . . . revenue loss to the government if the tax were repealed would be at least partially offset by an increase in revenue from the income tax. This would result not only from the stimulating effect repeal would have on transportation business generally, but also because the tax collected on business travel no longer would be a deductible business expense.

Because . . . the tax discriminates against those who do not have automobiles and are, therefore, compelled to use transportation subject to tax.

Because . . . it discriminates against travelers within the United States, as opposed to those traveling to foreign destinations to which the tax does not apply.

Because . . . by applying only to domestic travel, it discourages those who wish to "See America First," to the detriment not only of the public carriers, but also of the nation's resort and recreational industry.

Because . . . in short, the tax is discriminatory, inflationary, economically unsound, and is undermining the public carriers that are vital to our commerce and defense.

Missouri Pacific's New Electronic Hump Yard Now in Service

The eastern section of Missouri Pacific's new electronic "double hump" yard in the Northeast Industrial District of Kansas City, Mo., was recently completed and placed in daily operation. Work in progress on the western section of the \$13.5 million classification yard project is expected to be finished by the end of 1959.

Missouri Pacific handles approximately 27 per cent of the rail business originating and terminating in the Kansas City area which is a key point on the railroad's 10,000-mile system. Four operating divisions terminate there and interchange is made with ten other trunk line railroads and one terminal company. Improved efficiency of operations effected by the new Missouri Pacific facilities is expected to reduce by about one-half the time required in handling freight cars through this busy gateway.

The photo reproduced below is a view of the "down" side of the new east "hump," showing the yard office, tower and 194-foot master retarder. As a freight car rolls free down the incline it activates electronic devices that automatically weigh it. The data are fed into computers which control the retarders—braking devices which slow the cars to the desired speed set by the computers. Other automatic electronic devices check wind resistance, rolling resistance on both straight and curved track, measure the length of track where the car is headed, and keep count of the number of cars already stored there.

Honoring Tickets—All tickets, one-way and round-trip (except where optional or variable routes are permitted) will be honored over short line only.

TICKETS—(LOST, REDEMPTION, ETC.)

Children under five years of age free when accompanied by parent or guardian; five years of age and under twelve, one-half fare; twelve years of age or over, full fare.

Lost Tickets—If you lose your railroad ticket give notice of your loss to the conductor. Pay cash fare on train or purchase another ticket, taking receipt. Forward receipt with details of the loss to the Passenger Traffic Manager of the road from which you bought the original ticket, and you will be advised whether or not any refund can properly be made.

Redemption of Tickets—Tickets unused or partly used will be redeemed under tariff regulations at proper value and should be handled with R. J. McDermott, General Passenger Traffic Manager, St. Louis, Mo.

GENERAL INFORMATION

BAGGAGE—(ALLOWANCE, LIABILITY, MARKING, ETC.)

Hand Baggage in Pullman Cars—Passengers are requested, for the convenience and comfort of themselves and other passengers on the train, to check their hand baggage whenever possible, except that actually needed for personal use enroute. There is a limitation as to the size of baggage which can be placed under Pullman seats. The following are the maximum dimensions—9x19x28½ inches.

This Railroad will not guarantee to forward baggage or property on same train with passenger or within a given or specified time limit, but reserves the right to forward it upon a preceding or following train.

One hundred and fifty pounds of baggage, not exceeding \$100 in value, will be checked without charge for each adult passenger, and seventy-five pounds, not exceeding \$50 in value, for each child traveling on a half-ticket.

No single piece of baggage exceeding 300 pounds in weight or exceeding \$2,500 in value, will be checked. Free allowances subject to tariff stipulations as to contents, weight and value.

Unless a greater sum is declared by the passenger and charges paid for increased valuation at time of delivery to carrier, the value of baggage belonging to or checked for an adult passenger shall be deemed and agreed to be not in excess of \$100, and the value of the baggage belonging to or checked for a child traveling on a half ticket shall be deemed and agreed to be not in excess of \$50.

All baggage should be marked. Location of baggage delayed or astray is expedited when the container is marked with name or initials.

This railroad will not accept for transportation as baggage from any one passenger, property that is declared to exceed \$2,500 in value.

Money, jewelry, silverware, negotiable paper and like valuables, radios, household goods, liquids, explosives, fragile or perishable articles, should not be enclosed in baggage. Under no conditions will the carriers be responsible for such articles in baggage nor for damage caused by same.

Baby Carriages, Go-carts, Bicycles and similar articles enumerated in tariff when used in connection with journey will be checked and included in weight and value of passenger's baggage.

Dogs, Cats and Birds—In the United States dogs, cats, birds and other household pets, when in baskets or other containers, may be taken into private room accommodations of Sleeping cars. Or, they may be transported in baggage service subject to tariff regulations.

Lost Articles—Inquire of R. A. Watson, General Baggage Agent, St. Louis, Mo. Articles found in and around stations or upon trains should be turned over to Agent or Conductor, or forwarded to R. A. Watson, General Baggage Agent, St. Louis, Mo.

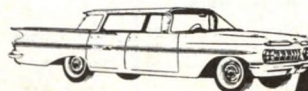

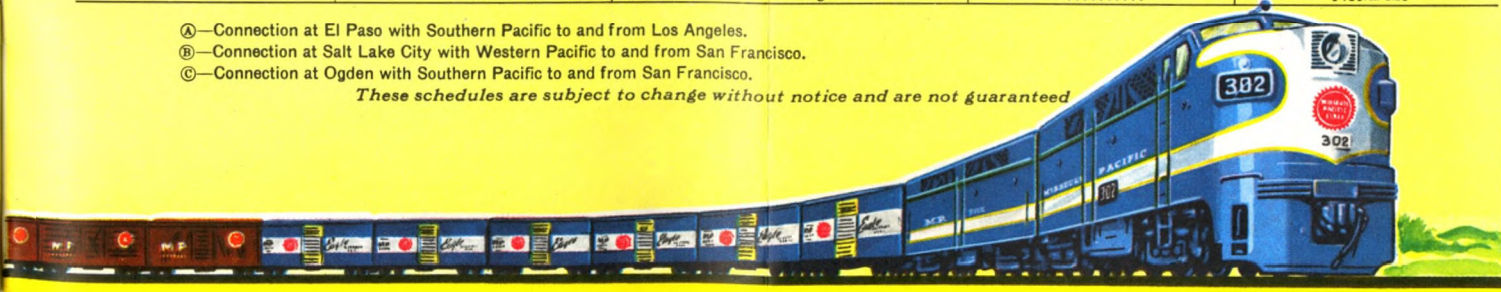
