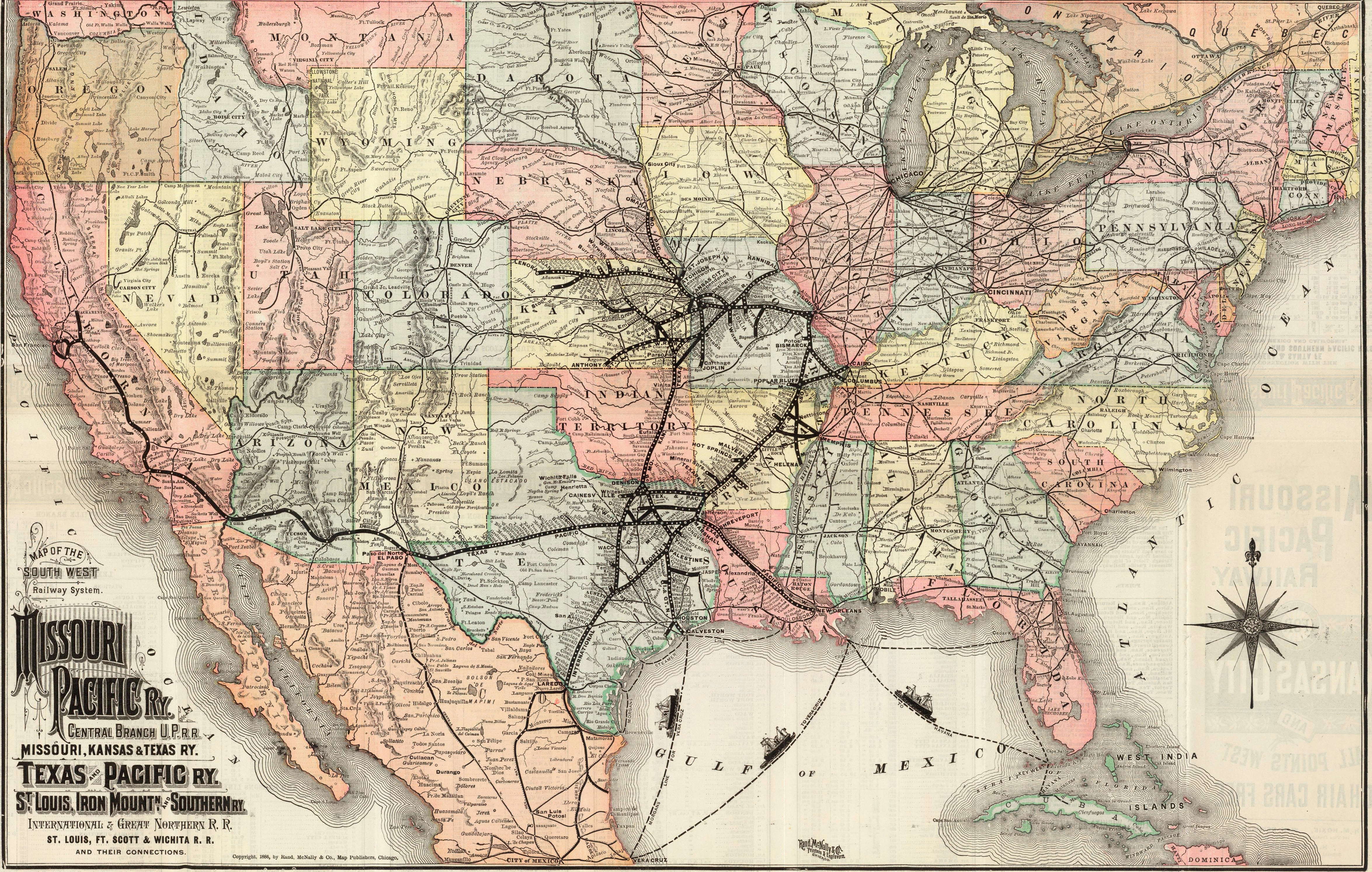

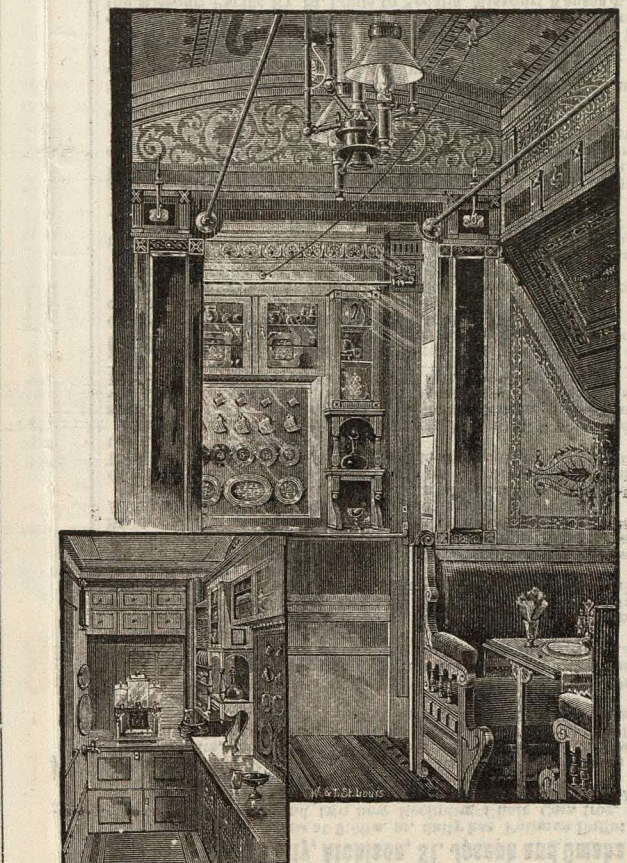
MAP OF THE SOUTH WEST Railway System.
