The adventurous ones came first . . . the miners and the trappers, followed by the pioneers with their plows and their cattle, pushing the frontier westward, mile by mile.

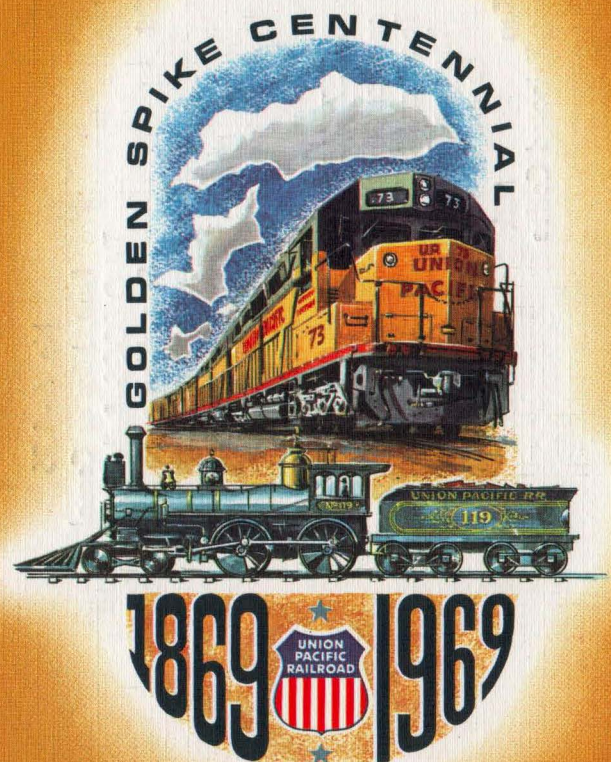
