

The West was a wilderness of prairie, mountains, and plains... a vast hunting ground of the Indians. Transportation was by horse, by foot, or by stagecoach.


The adventurous ones came first . . . the miners and the trappers, followed by the pioneers with their plows and their cattle, pushing the frontier westward, mile by mile.
