Mother Nature laid out the geographical and natural advantages that have made Las Vegas a rendezvous for travelers to and from California since the covered wagon days. Man has added those vacation and resort features which attract more than seven million visitors a year.

Modern Fremont Street, with its 13-story skyscraper Hotel Fremont, illustrates the city's tremendous growth from a pre-war population of 8,000 to over 50,000 in 1958. Along this street, where casinos never close, are also fine shops, department stores, theatres, restaurants and offices.

A few miles south begins Las Vegas' fabulous "Strip," a five mile boulevard with a dozen or more multi-million dollar resort hotels interspersed with modern shops and other business. Here perform nightly more international stars of stage, radio, TV and even Opera than in any other one place in the world. In fact Las Vegas is often called the "Entertainment Capital of the World." Adjacent to "The Strip" a new multi-million dollar Convention Center will bring many national conventions to Las Vegas.

Las Vegas has unexcelled rail service with Union Pacific Domeliners "City of Los Angeles" and "City of St. Louis" respectively operating between Chicago or St. Louis and Los Angeles. Las Vegas has its own special train named for it, the Streamliner "City of Las Vegas," which makes a daytime round trip between Los Angeles and Las Vegas.
