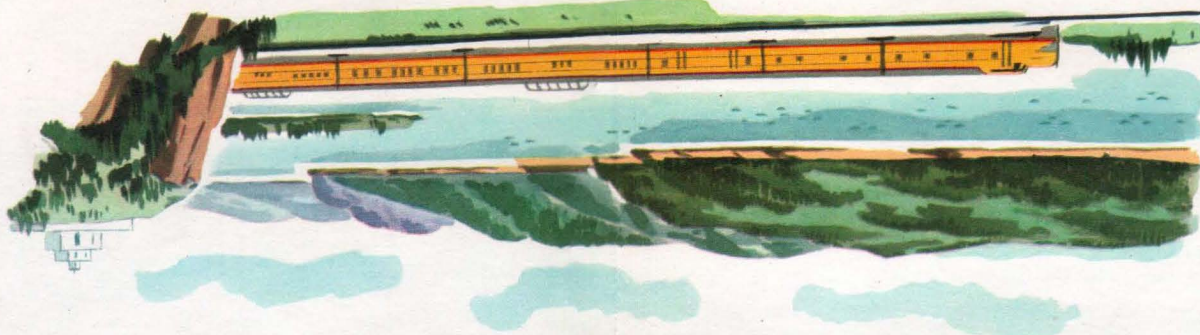
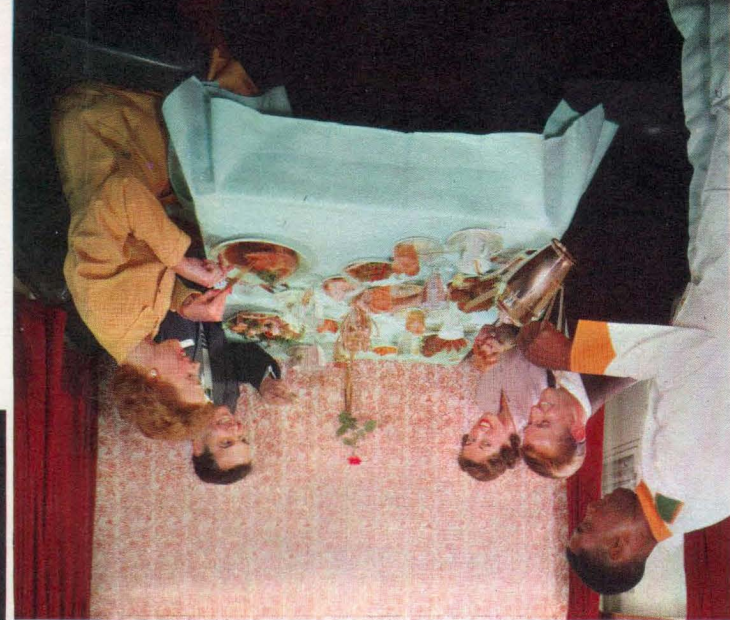




The luxurious main dining car on the lower level.



The Astra Dome dining car where superlative meals are served.



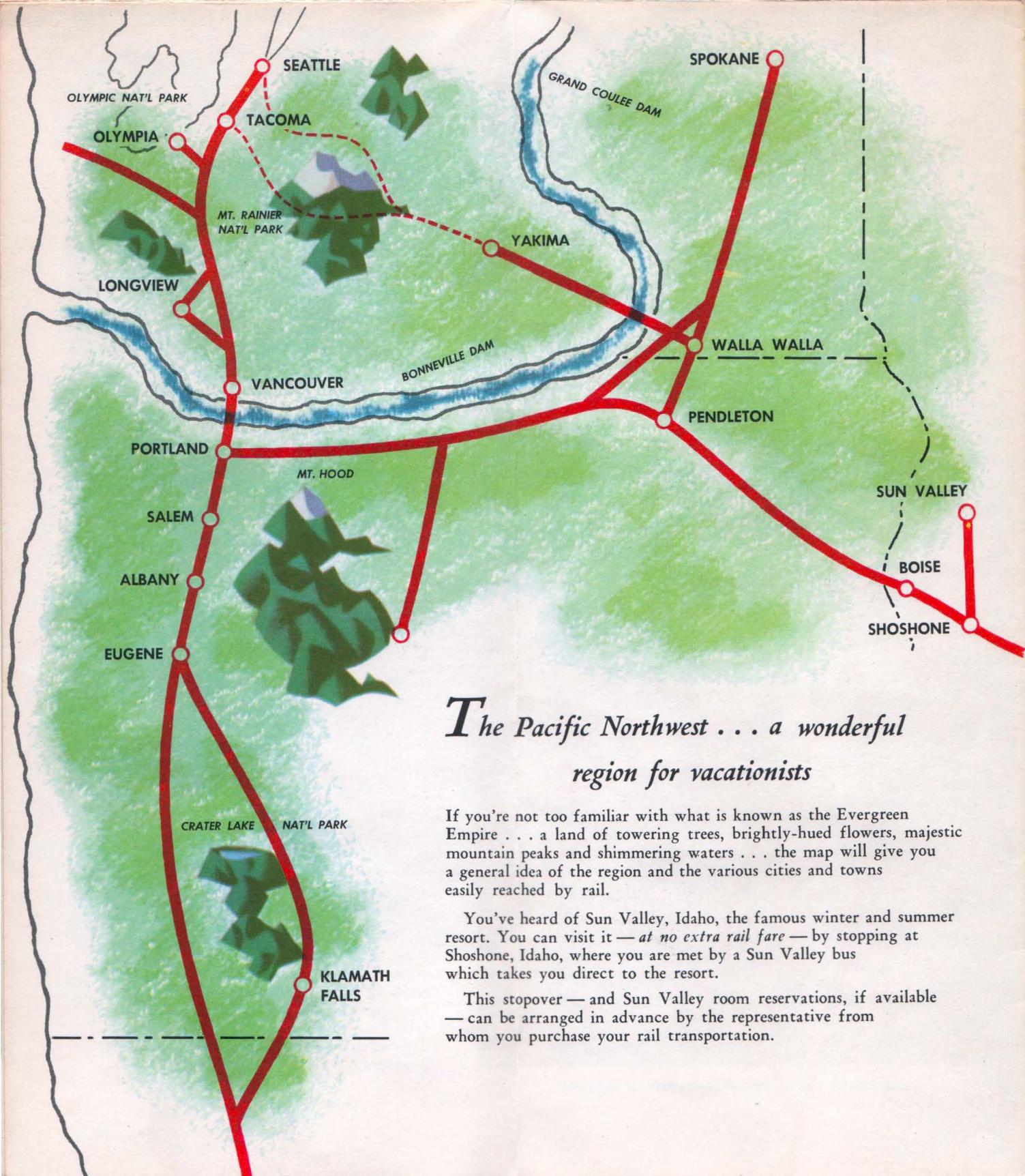
The Gold Room, with gold plated dinner service, available for small private parties.

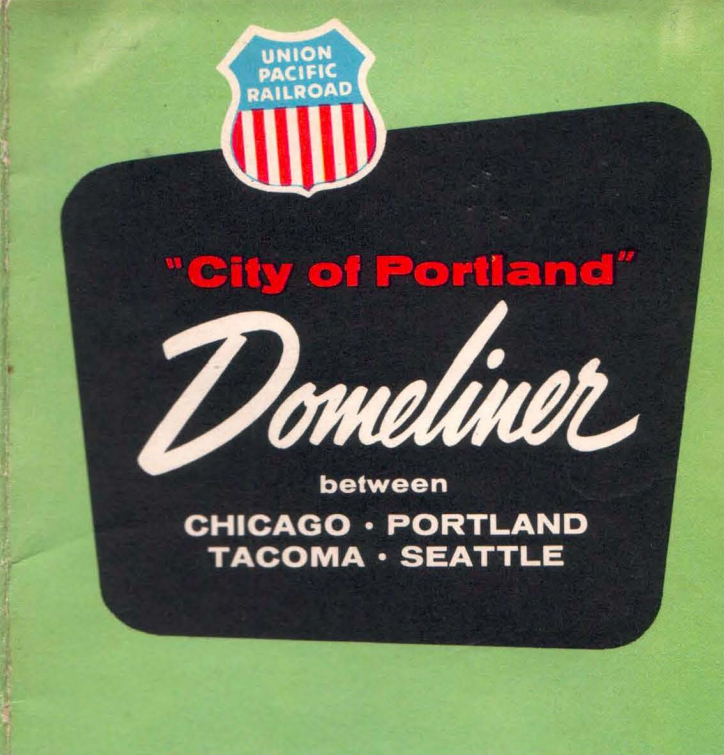
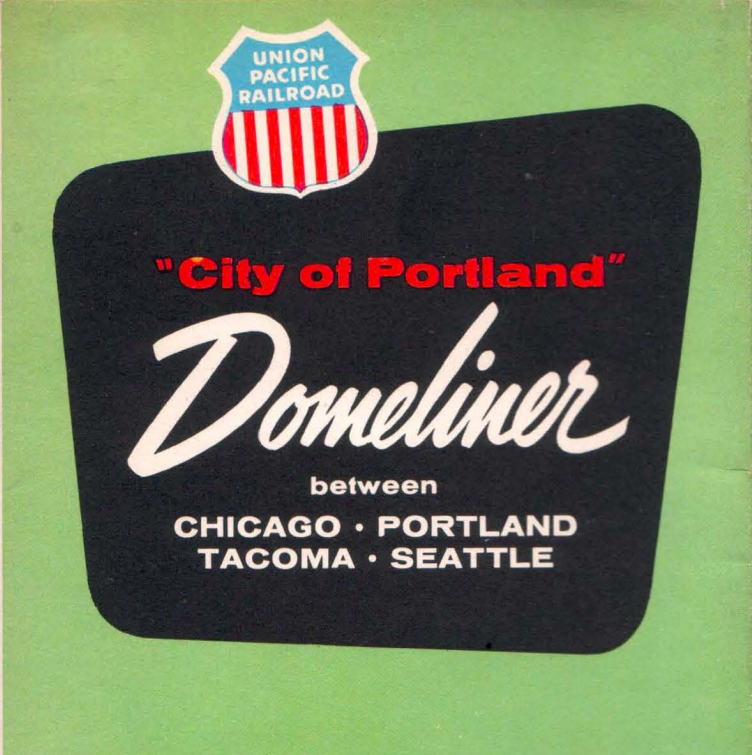


## The Pacific Northwest . . . a wonderful region for vacationists
