

Located in Northern Arizona, the Grand Canyon is actually a vast network of yawning chasms, following the course of the surging Colorado River for 217 miles. Countless artists have painted its enthralling magnificence, and volumes have been written about it, but the Grand Canyon of Arizona must be seen with your own eyes to be fully appreciated.

A good vantage point is from beautiful Grand Canyon Lodge on the brink of the North Rim, 1,000 feet higher than the opposite rim, 12 miles distant. To gaze through the broad windows of the Lodge at the great sea of shifting, changing rainbow colors of the unfathomable gorge is an exalting experience. Other vantage points are Point Imperial, pictured here, the highest point on the North Rim, Cape Final, Cape Royal, Farview Point and Point Sublime.

Grand Canyon is linked by paved highways with nearby Zion and Bryce Canyon National Parks in Southern Utah. This group of three scenic wonders attracts thousands of vacationists annually.

Many travelers enroute to or from California, via Union Pacific Railroad, arrange to take the popular motor bus tours of the parks.
