
The towered Ferry Building, famous the world over, stands at the foot of Market Street, which runs diagonally southwest to Twin Peaks, dividing the city in half. Along this broad thoroughfare operate four surface car lines, vying with heavy motor vehicle traffic for the right-of-way, while throngs of bustling pedestrians fill the sidewalks—all giving credence to the general belief that San Francisco is a city of swift tempo.

In certain quarters of San Francisco there is more than a suggestion of foreign cities. At one point you may be reminded of Paris, and not far away is world-famous Chinatown with strange pagoda-like structures lining the streets. Oriental costume mingles with American and quaint Chinese patter may be heard on all sides. The fishing fleet, which ties up at Fisherman's Wharf, is largely manned by descendants of the early Italian fishermen of the city. But, there is hardly a land on the face of the earth that is not well represented in San Francisco's polyglot population.

Perhaps it is this fusing of so many races that contributes to the strength and vigor of San Francisco, and adds so much to its cosmopolitan charm. Truly, it is one of the great cities of the world.
