Crater Lake, Oregon, and Wizard Island


Crater Lake National Park

RATER LAKE NATIONAL PARK is in southern Oregon, in the midst of the Cascade Mountains. Born in the ruin of the extinct volcano, Mt. Mazama, beautiful Crater Lake is the bluest and deepest of lakes, yet when the water is dipped up it is crystal clear. Its glorious colors range from deep indigo and sapphire blue to turquoise and ultramarine. An atmosphere of mystery broods over its lovely surface, and its precipitous, tinted lava walls, 2,000 feet high, suggest unearthly forms. Two strange islands alone break the placid surface of the lake. One of these, Wizard Island, is a crater within a crater; while against the eastern shore a craggy islet called the Phantom Ship appears and disappears in the shifting light. Indian legends declare the lake to be the dwelling place of gods and demons. It has no outlet.

When discovered Crater Lake contained no fish, but it is now well stocked with rainbow and black spotted trout, noted for their fighting qualities. There are rowboats and launches for hire. There are good trails to several peaks and canyons in the vicinity; beautiful wild flowers are numerous; and a number of wild animals, particularly bears, find refuge there.

The Park may be reached either from Medford, on the west, or from Klamath Falls, on the east; auto stages operate daily to the commodious lodge occupying an imposing site on the southern rim. The season is approximately from July 1st to September 30th. In addition to the lodge, tent and camp accommodations are available and every comfort is provided for visitors.

Crater Lake may be visited in connection with trips to California and the Pacific Northwest via the fine fast trains of the Union Pacific.
