



Ogden, Utah

OGDEN, UTAH, at the juncture of the Ogden and Weber rivers, near the western base of the lofty Wasatch Range, was founded in 1848, and laid out in 1850 under the direction of Brigham Young, the Mormon leader. Great Salt Lake lies ten miles westward. The second largest city in Utah, Ogden has excellent utilities, modern hotels and public buildings. The State Industrial School and State institutions for the deaf and blind are located there. Ogden is also an important live stock, meat packing and manufacturing center.

Ogden Canyon, about two miles east of the city, and reached by fast electric cars and a hard-surfaced automobile road, is one of the most picturesque gorges in the West. In its upper reaches the canyon is extremely narrow and precipitous, and the surrounding peaks rise to lofty heights. At the bottom is a sparkling trout stream, the Ogden River, whose ceaseless action through long geologic periods cut the stupendous passageway. Trolley cars ascend seven miles to an attractive rustic hotel, the Hermitage, where are some of the most impressive vistas of cliffs and crags.

Ogden is on the double-track main line of the Union Pacific System, reached from Chicago, Omaha, St. Louis, Kansas City, Denver and the East via fast Pullman trains operating on convenient schedules, and from the Pacific Northwest and Southern California by similar Union Pacific service. From San Francisco it is reached via the Southern Pacific's direct line. Ogden is a gateway to Yellowstone and Zion National Parks.
