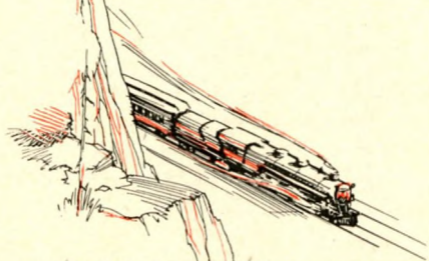

THE pioneers who followed the Old Oregon Trail found that crossing the western half of the American continent was a considerable journey.

The Oregon Trail is still a preferred route between the Middle West and the North Pacific Coast, but how differently! Today, the Portland Limited covers the same route in $61\frac{1}{4}$ hours eastbound and 63 hours westbound, that took weeks and months for the ox teams and prairie schooners of years ago.

The only through train between Chicago and Portland, Oregon, the Portland Limited well deserves its reputation as one of the best trains linking the Middle West with the great Pacific Northwest.

Daytime Privacy

Your Pullman section on the Portland Limited is almost as secluded as if it were a drawing room or a compartment. Permanent headboards between berths insure each passenger a measure of privacy. Each berth has its own lighting and ventilating control, adjustable at will.

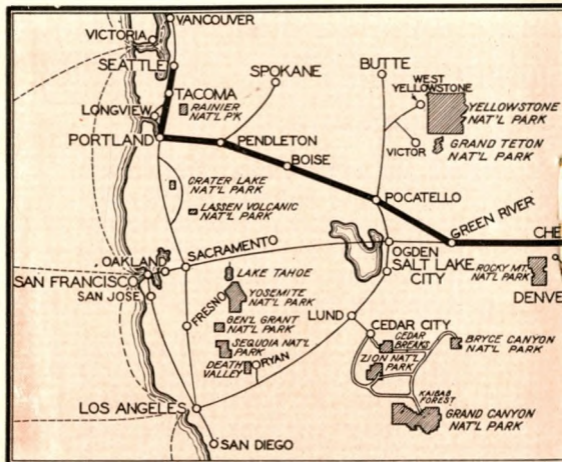


Leisure- Lounges

In summer, this car is supplemented by an open-top sight-seeing car for that part of the trip between The Dalles and Portland, through the Columbia River gorge.

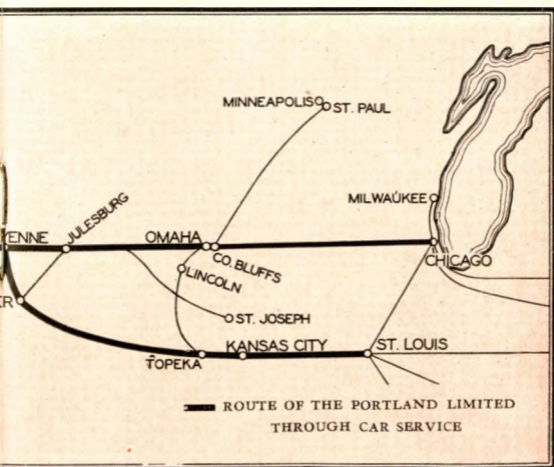

The Men's Lounge

The midsection of the observation car is the men's sanctum, made masculine by deep leather chairs and convenient ash trays, stock reports and card tables. The observation car attendant serves refreshments from the buffet; newspapers and magazines are in the rack of the main lounge, just outside.



The Ladies' Lounge

The observation car also has a quiet retreat especially for its women passengers. Forward of the men's lounge is a ladies' lounge with mirrors and deep, comfortable chairs; just the quiet kind of a corner for an hour with a magazine, or an intimate chat between friends.



The Barber

The invigoration of a shampoo or a massage, the comfort of haircut, bob or shave are available to the passengers on the Portland Limited. The barber is an expert and he is equally adept at serving either men or women.



The Bathroom

Just off the barber shop, forward in the observation car, is a spic-and-span bathroom equipped for both tub and shower baths, with fluffy towels and adequate space for a complete toilet. The bath is for the use of all passengers, and appointments for its use may be made with the barber.



The Observation End

For over 2000 miles between the Great Lakes and the North Pacific Coast, a striking array of scenery extends on either side of the Overland Route. Not the least popular of the Portland Limited's appointments is a broad observation platform, with comfortable lounging chairs from which to view the passing landscape.
