The Gates of Yosemite and the Bridal Veil Falls

Yosemite National Park

YOSEMITE, with its mighty peaks and waterfalls and the earth's oldest and tallest trees, ranks high among the world's wonders. The Park covers an area thirty-six by forty-eight miles, yet many of its most spectacular sights are grouped together in the Yosemite Valley—a marvelous gorge only seven miles long and from one-half mile to one mile wide. The floor of this canyon-valley is verdure-clad, and in spring and summer is dotted with wild flowers, the Merced River flowing through its meadowlands and park-like forests. Yosemite is a realm of granite precipices, stately spires and domes and magnificent waterfalls. El Capitan rises 3,604 feet; Sentinel Rock is 3,100 feet high; Glacier Point, 3,250 feet; and the Half Dome, 4,892 feet. Yosemite Falls plunges half a mile over the canyon rim, one of the grandest cataracts on earth. Vernal, Nevada, and Illilouette Falls have individual aspects of beauty. Ribbon Falls is a glistening thread of 1,612 feet, while Bridal Veil, perhaps most graceful of all, drops 940 feet.

The Mariposa Grove of Big Trees stands within the Park. The tallest Sequoia is 331 feet high and the largest are over twenty-nine feet in diameter. The age of some of these giants is estimated at more than 3,000 years.

Yosemite, which is open the year around and has excellent hotels, lodges and camps, is reached via the Union Pacific and its connections to Merced, whence regular rail and auto stage service is maintained into the Park. From Truckee, California, on the Union Pacific's Overland Route, a side trip may be made to beautiful Lake Tahoe, whence there is auto-bus service over the Tioga Scenic Highway into Yosemite during the season.
