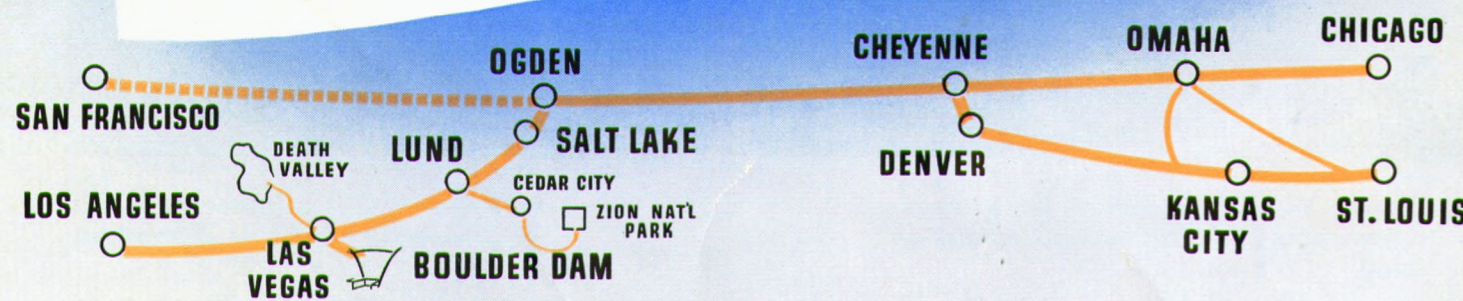


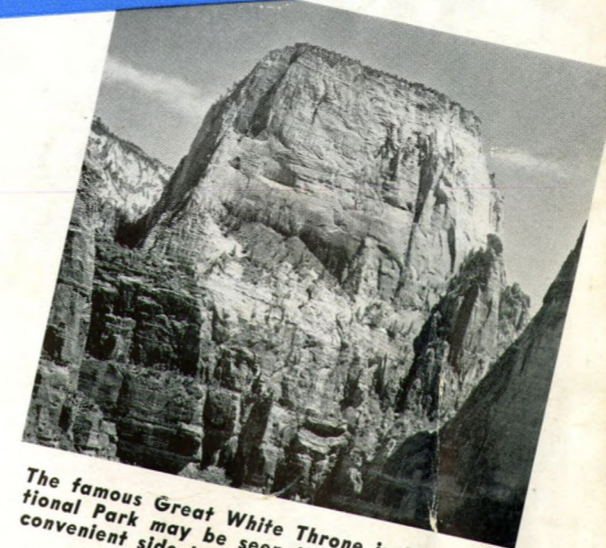
BOULDER DAM

One of the greatest attractions in America, an inexpensive, easy side trip for Union Pacific passengers on the way to or from CALIFORNIA



ZION NATIONAL PARK UTAH

Colorful scenery, a mild winter climate and sparkling sunshine combine to make Zion an ideal attraction when en route to or from California.



The famous Great White Throne in Zion National Park may be seen the year-round on convenient side trips from Cedar City, Utah.

THREE LOW-COST TOURS

● Your patrons have their choice of three separate side-trips from Lund, Utah. For example, Pacific Limited passengers arriving Lund 6:44 AM, westbound, can board a waiting bus for Cedar City, then to Zion for lunch, and back to Lund at 4:00 PM, to continue West on the Los Angeles Limited or the Challenger.

All Expense Cost—\$10.75

● Westbound passengers arriving Lund in the afternoon will be taken by bus to Cedar City for dinner and lodging at the El Escalante Hotel—breakfast next morning—then to Zion and return to Lund 4 o'clock that afternoon.

All Expense Cost—\$15

● Eastbound passengers arriving Lund 12:17 PM on the Los Angeles Limited, or 12:41 PM on the Challenger, can make the complete Zion side-trip by bus, spend the night at Zion with dinner, and breakfast next day, included—and return to Lund at 12 noon in time to proceed East on the Los Angeles Limited or the Challenger.

All Expense Cost—\$14.75

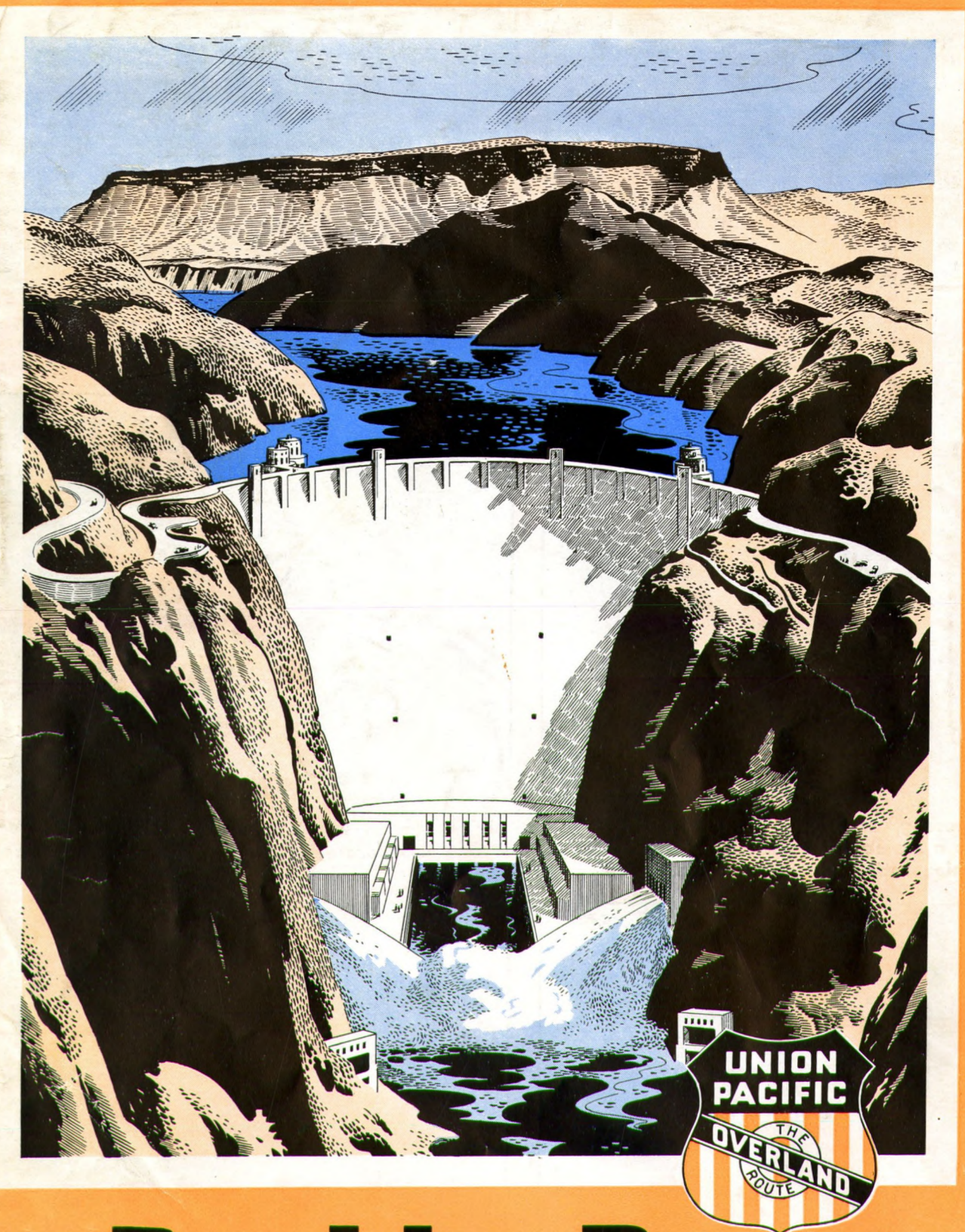

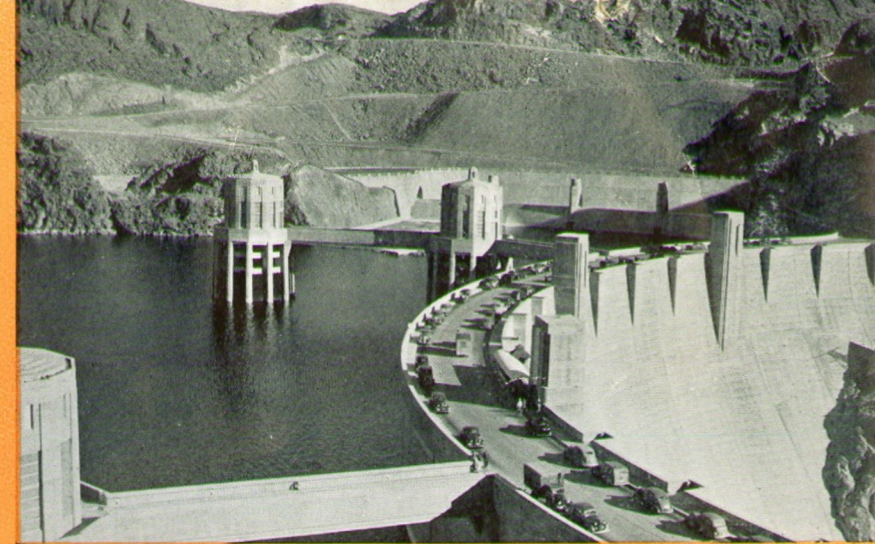


Boulder Dam

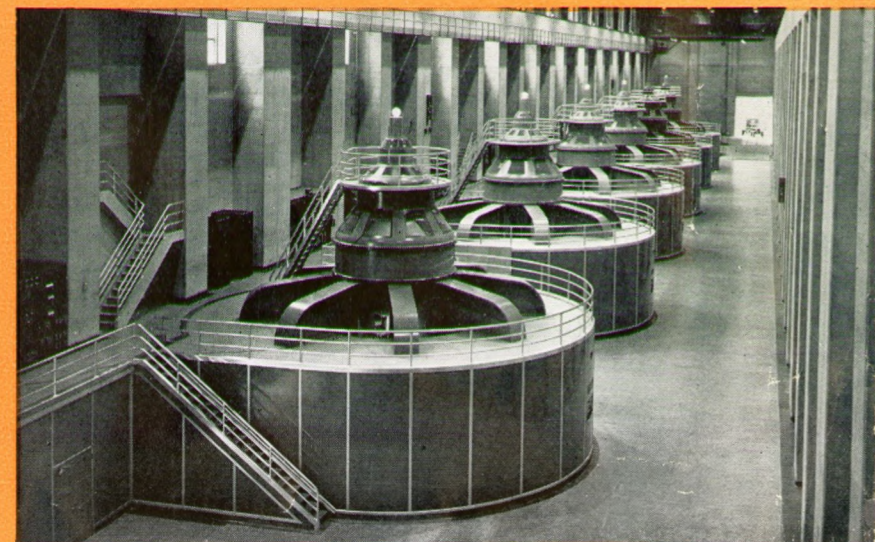

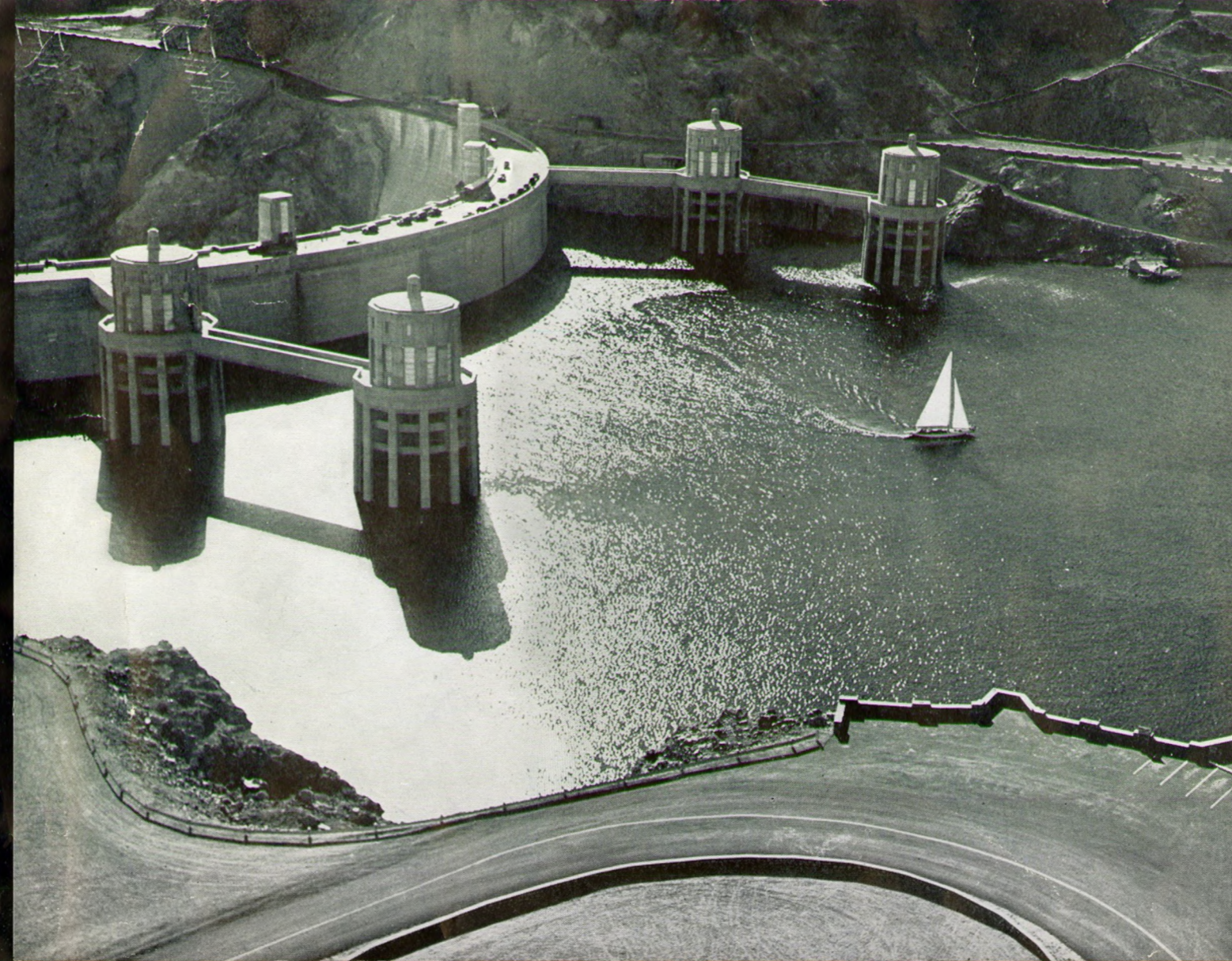
These great bronze figures stand as a memorial to those whose vision made Boulder Dam a reality.

This scene from Lookout Point is typical of the many spectacular views at Boulder Dam.



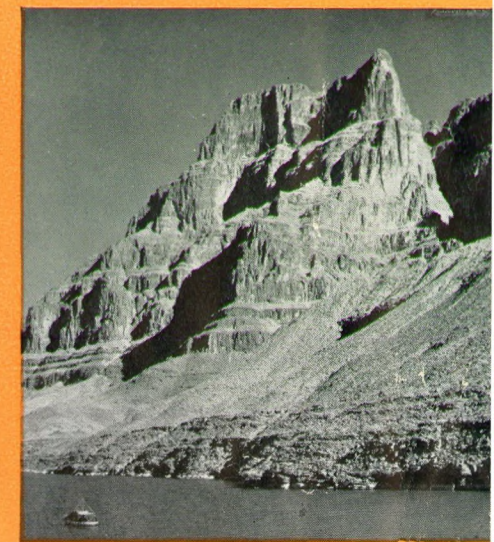

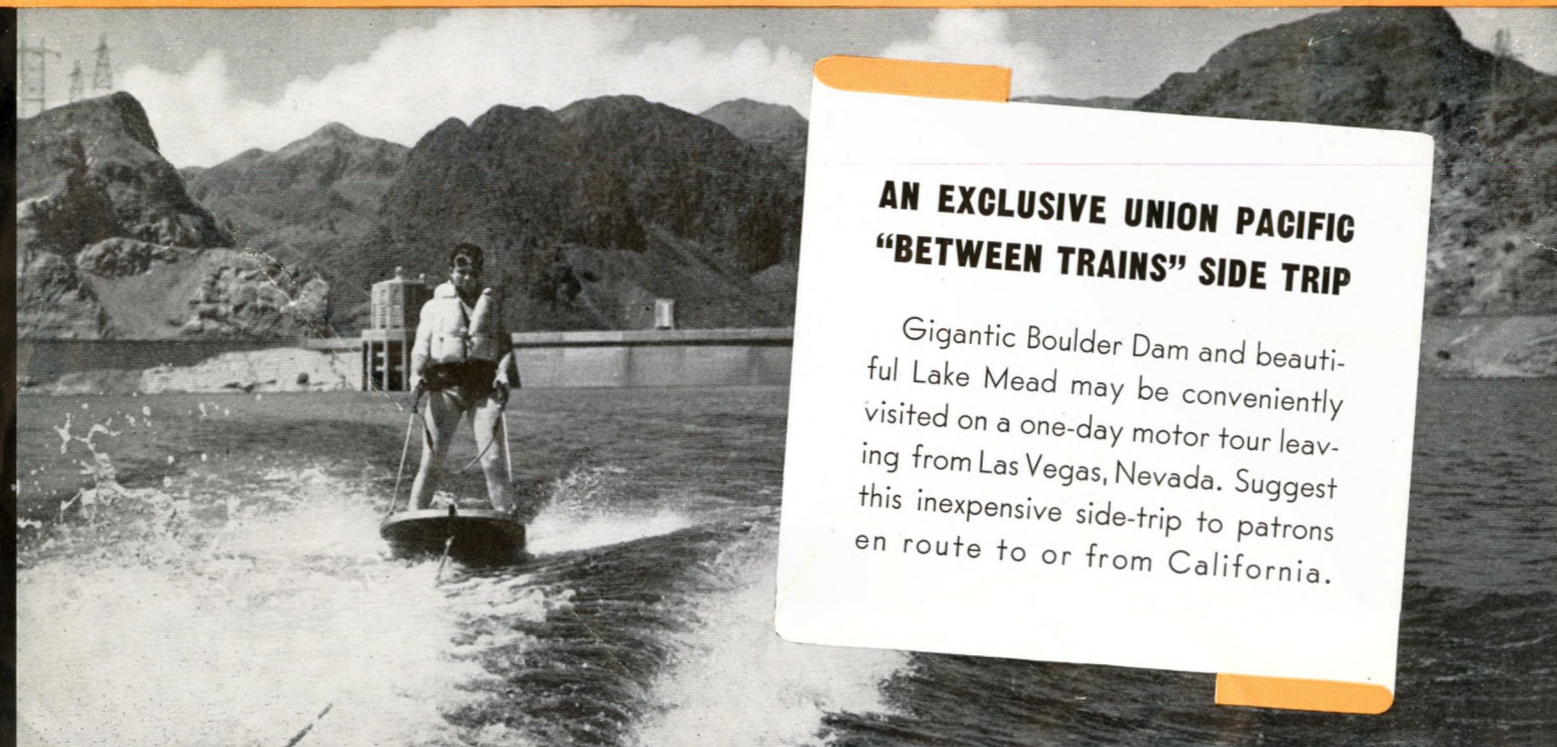

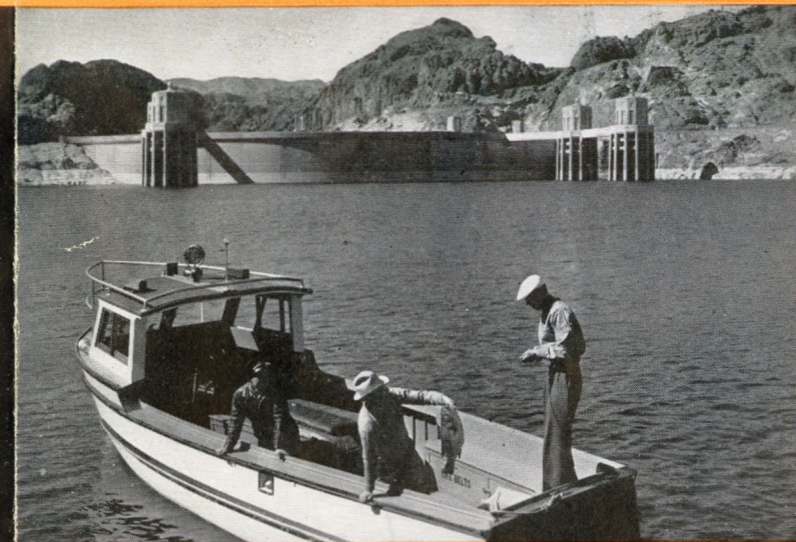
