

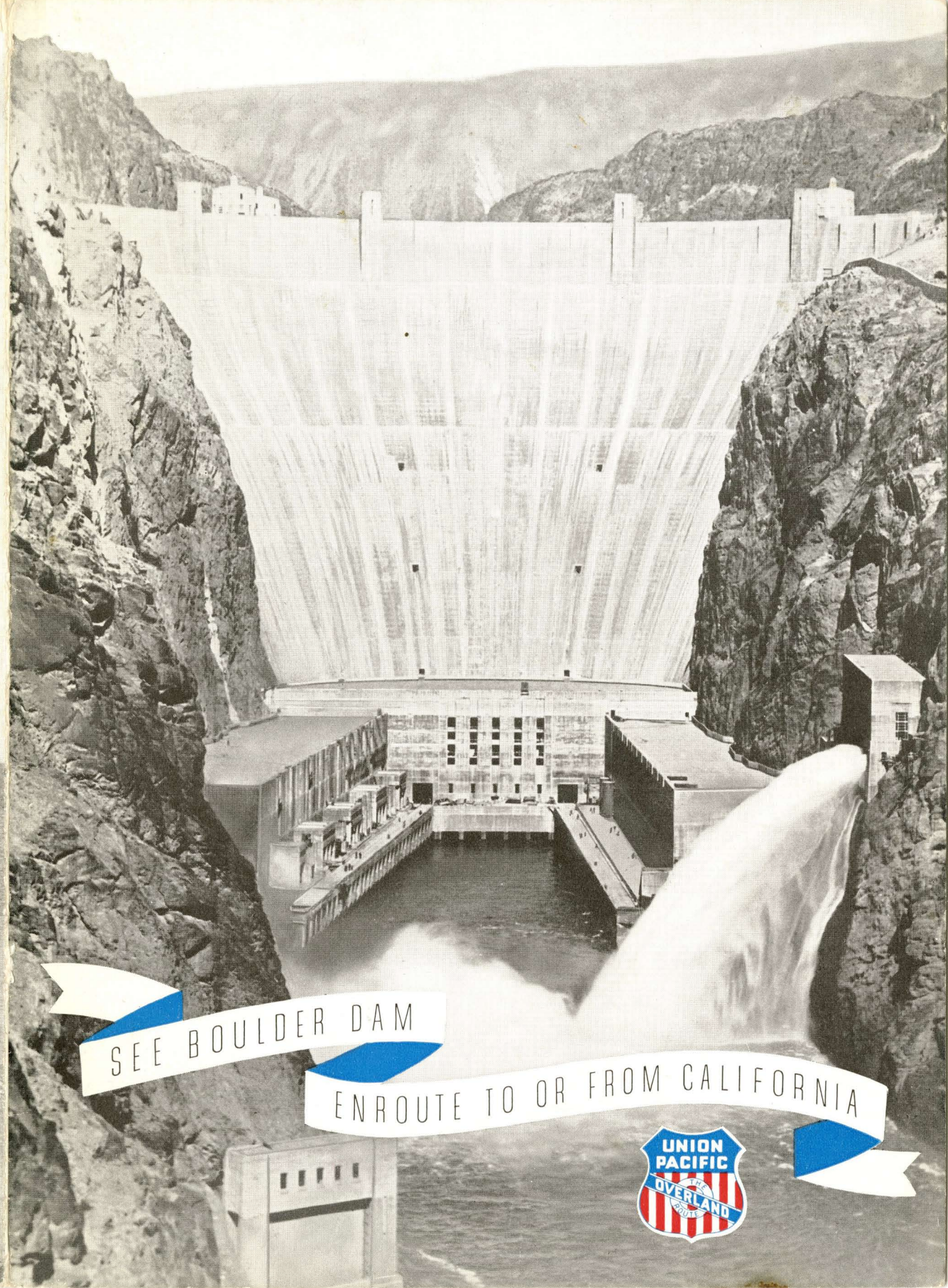
## Southern California
