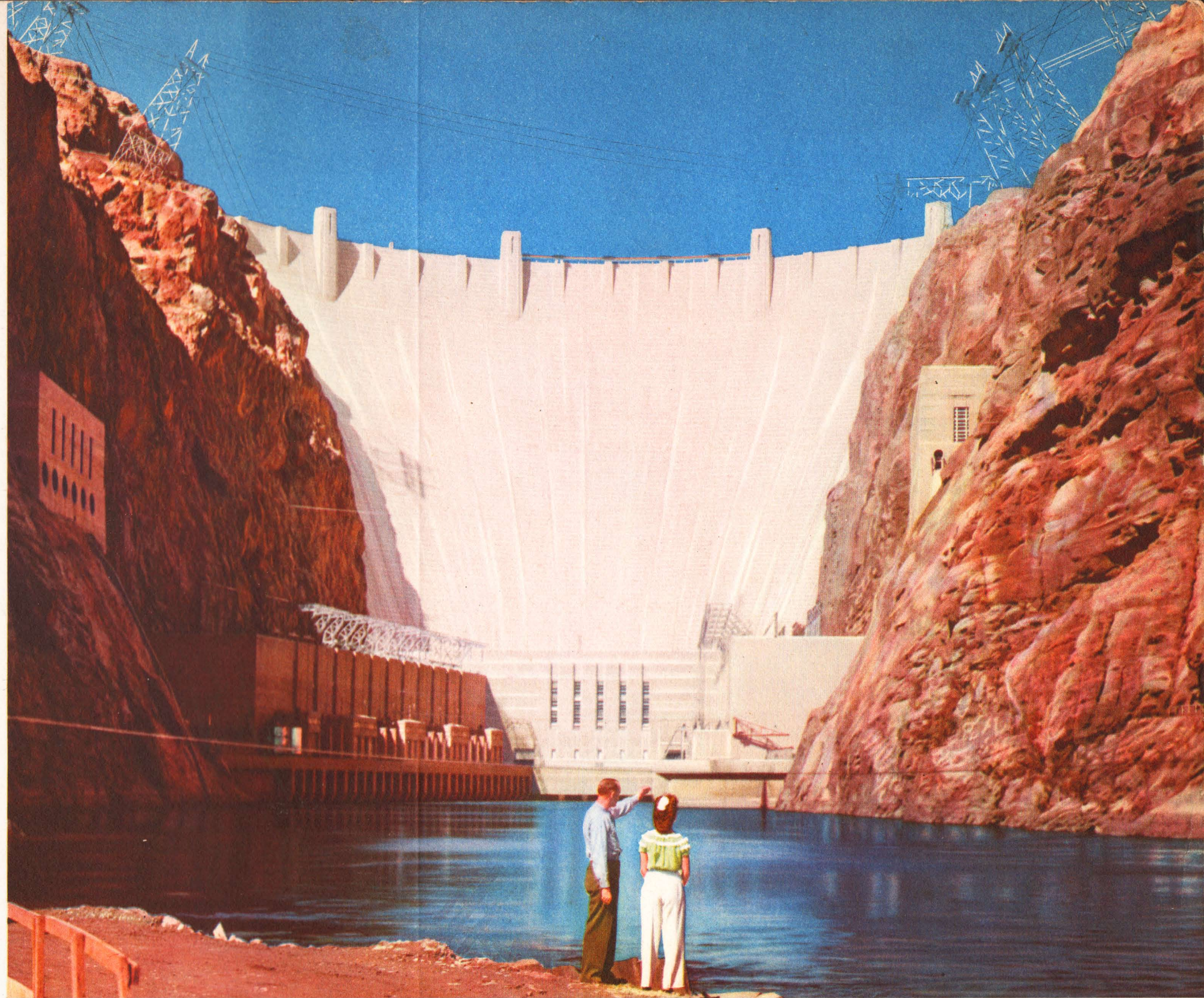




Until finally harnessed and controlled by Boulder Dam in 1936, the Colorado River was America's most dangerous and one of its most destructive streams. Now it is a highly useful servant of the great Southwest. Its flood waters are controlled and stored in the artificially created Lake Mead above the Dam and used as needed to maintain a uniform flow of water in the river. The operation of Boulder Dam has entirely changed the character of that part of the Colorado River that lies below the Grand Canyon. Great areas in southern California and Arizona now have a steady supply of water for both irrigation and domestic uses, and an immense reserve of electric energy for light and power.

This is an engineering achievement that ranks high among those of our time. Boulder Dam itself is a piece of construction gigantic enough to stagger the imagination. Its crest is 727 feet above river bedrock and is 1,282 feet long. The Dam's thickness is 45 feet at the top and 660 feet at the bottom. It is quickly reached from Las Vegas, Nev., the rail gateway, 29 miles distant.
