**A**MONG the many important factors which contributed to the development of the West, The Pony Express ranks as the most romantic, daring business venture of frontier day history. Inaugurated April 3, 1860, this dramatic communication service between the Missouri River and California reduced the time of transmitting news across the country from twenty-one days to ten days. Sixty riders, noted for their lithe, wiry physiques, bravery and coolness in the face of great personal danger, rode from 100 to 140 miles each — at break-neck speed — with relays of horses at distances of from 20 to 25 miles. Rain, hail, snow or sleet — “road-agents”, hostile Indians — there was no delay. In all, 650,000 miles were ridden by the Pony Express riders before this service was replaced by transcontinental telegraph and railroad.

This train, The Pony Express, was named to perpetuate the memory of the first Pony Express. Today you travel safely, swiftly, in complete air-conditioned comfort, overnight, across a mountainous country that spelled extreme hardship and danger to Pony Express riders of yesterday.
