California Poppy (Eschscholtzia californica)

State flower and best known of all California wild flowers. Blossoms are two to three inches in diameter, deep golden yellow. Plants grow about a foot high. Blooms February to June. Historic San Gabriel Mission, near Los Angeles, California.

THE name "California" was taken from Ordonez de Montalvo's romance of chivalry, *Las Sergas de Esplandian* (Madrid, 1510), in which is told of black Amazons ruling an island of this name "to the right of the Indies, very near the quarter of the terrestrial paradise."

Perhaps the charm of our California lies in the fact that it means many things to many people. Here are orange groves and mountains; flowered valleys and desert lands; historic missions and Movieland; the sparkling waters of a great sea and virgin forests with mighty trees older than any other living thing; then of course there is metropolitan city life for those who prefer that.

Contrasts? Yes, fascinating, never ending contrasts. There are even places where one may actually look from sea to desert and from snow to orange groves simply by turning his head!

The Los Angeles Limited, with the California Poppy (state flower) as its motif, gives the traveler a *fore*taste and *after*taste of the atmosphere and charm of California. It, too, means many things to many people, and not the least of these is COMFORT.
