## PANIIN

Established in 1909 by a group of far sighted citizens as a non-sectarian institu tion with an enrollment of 26 students, the present Municipal University of Omaha has grown to an enrollment of 4,000 students. The original campus was in the north part of the city. Enrollment was steady and rapid and in 1928 a movement was started which resulted, two years later, in the school becoming municipally-owned and tax-sup-
ported. 1936 the Board of Regents selected a
In 19 new 52 -acre campus site in the west section of the city and in the center of Omaha's finest residential area. In the same year the University received a grant from the Pub lic Works Administration, which, together with accrued building funds, financed the present building of Georgian design, completely air-conditioned and evaluated at a million and a half dollars. A large field house gymnasium building is under con struction west of the present structure. A ten-year building program includes plans for three other structures-a library, an ap plied sciences building, and a student union building.

Although the bulk of the school's enroll ment comes from the city itself, the insti tution draws students from many other states. Last year, for example, the enroll ment represented 22 states and a number of foreign countries.

The University offers an excellent educa tional program, fully accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools, and six other leading educational societies. It has the largest eve ning school program between Chicago and Denver.
