The university which a short sixteen years ago began in a single building with a faculty of 18 and a student body of 250 now has 12 buildings, a faculty of 260 , and a student body of 5,000 . The recently com pleted University Playhouse is one of the best technically-equipped and most attrac tive educational theaters in the United States.
