



When the founding fathers of the present University of California first selected a site for the "College of California" in 1855, on what is now the four-block area between Franklin and Harrison and Twelfth and Fourteenth streets in Oakland, little did they realize that the institution would grow to its present stature, the world's largest university.

The Berkeley campus is the oldest and largest of eight campuses making up the University of California. Its 600-acre campus is dominated by the 307-foot Campanile tower. Here is the world's greatest cyclotron, where much of the research which led to the atom bomb was done.

On the Berkeley campus is the Doe Memorial library, with over a million and a half bound volumes on its shelves, and here also is the Memorial Stadium, home field of the California Bears, which seats 80,000 persons.

The forty permanent buildings have been augmented by many temporary buildings to accommodate the large post-war enrollment which, in 1947, reached a total over 23,000.

Other campuses which are integral parts of the University of California are the Medical Center, the California School of Fine Arts, and Hastings College of the Law, in San Francisco; the University of California at Los Angeles; the Scripps Institution of Oceanography at LaJolla; the Lick Observatory at Mount Hamilton; the Citrus Experiment Station at Riverside, and Santa Barbara College at Santa Barbara.
