

The University of California at Los Angeles, more commonly known by its initials "UCLA", is an integral part of the University of California and the parent campus at Berkeley.

Its 390-acre campus is situated on the lower south slope of the Santa Monica mountains, which overlook Hollywood and the western part of Los Angeles. More than 14,000 students are loyal "Uclans".

In 1882 the first seeds of the Los Angeles State Normal School were planted on five acres of ground, now the site of the Los Angeles City Library in the heart of the metropolitan area. In 1914 the campus was moved to a site on North Vermont Avenue. Roots and branches spread rapidly and it became apparent a move was imperative. In 1928, after the state legislature had provided funds for the buildings, and Los Angeles and surrounding communities donated land for the present campus in Westwood, construction of the present buildings started. Growing pains again assailed UCLA after World War II and a \$38,000,000 expansion program is now under way. Included are plans for a \$15,000,000 medical school and pertinent facilities, and a law school building. A new law school will begin in the Fall of 1949, and it is anticipated that the Medical School will initiate courses in the Fall of 1951.

At the present time the University embodies several schools and colleges including the Colleges of Letters and Science, Business Administration, Engineering, Applied Arts, Agriculture, School of Education, Summer School of Surveying, Bureau of Governmental Research, the Graduate Division, and the School of Public Health.
