## UNION (ilil)

The University of California at Lo Angeles, more commonly known by its initials "UCLA", is an integral part of the University of California and the parent campus at Berkeley
Its 390 -acre campus is situated on the lower south slope of the Santa Monic mountains, which overlook Hollywood and he western part of Los Angeles. More than 14,000 students are loyal "Uclans"
In 1882 the first seeds of the Los An geles State Normal School were planted on five acres of ground now the site of the Los Angeles City Library in the heart of the metropolitan area. In 1914 the campus was moved to a site on North Vermont Avenue. Roots and branches spread rapid $y$ and it mperative became apparent a move legis hature had provided funds for the build ings, and Los Angeles and surrounding communities donated land for the pres ent campus in Westwood, construction of the present buildings started. Growing pains again assailed UCLA after Worlc War II and a $\$ 38,000,000$ expansion pro gram is now under way. Included are plan or a $\$ 15,000,000$ medical school and pertinent facilities, and a law school build ing. A new law school will begin in the Fall of 1949, and it is anticipated that the Medical School will initiate courses in the Fall of 1951.
At the present time the University em bodies several schools and colleges includ ing the Colleges of Letters and Science Business Administration, Engineering, Ap plied Arts, Agriculture, School of Educa tion, Summer School of Surveying, Bureau of Governmental Research, the Graduate Division, and the School of Public Health
