

Crowning a hilltop overlooking more than one thousand acres of fertile Nebraska farmland, ten miles west of Omaha, is Father Flanagan's Boys' Home, known throughout the world as "Boys Town." It is a home, not an institution, where homeless and underprivileged boys are given devoted care and enjoy the advantages of a good Christian education.

Founded December 12, 1917 by the late Father Edward J. Flanagan in a two-story brick building in Omaha with \$90 borrowed to pay the first month's rent, and with five homeless waifs as its first citizens, Boys Town was moved to its present location in 1921. Today it has grown to a beautiful campus with 50 buildings, including modern cottages and apartments for its more than 800 young citizens, up-to-date grade and high school buildings, a wellequipped trade school, chapel, dining halls, auditorium, field house and gymnasiums, extensive playgrounds and recreational areas, and modern farm buildings. In addition to the academic curriculum, training in more than a dozen trades is offered Boys Town citizens.

Among the many activities which have brought the work of Boys Town before the public, perhaps none is better known than the Boys Town Choir, which has appeared in leading concert halls from New England to the Pacific Coast.

Built on the credo that, given the proper understanding, care and training, there is no such thing as a bad boy, tangible proof of this philosophy is found in the lives of more than seven thousand boys of every creed and color, from every state in the Union, who have called Boys Town their home.

Monsignor Nicholas H. Wegner has been director of Boys Town since the death of Monsignor (Father) Flanagan in Berlin, Germany, in 1948, while on a youth welfare mission for the United States Government.
