

First chartered in 1859 as "Lawrence University," the University of Kansas did not actually become a reality until the year 1862 when an act of the state legislature provided for its organization. In September 1866 the first classes were held in Old North College, the University's first building, with an enrollment of 55. Today the University of Kansas campus at Lawrence and the Medical and Nursing School in Kansas City have an enrollment of approximately 10,000 full-time students. An additional 25,000 are on extension and part-time rolls.

The Lawrence campus is situated atop Mt. Oread, named by New England emigrants in 1854, an elevated area described as "far above the golden valley" It is one of the most sightly campuses in the country, its vast expanse of 317 acres being abundantly landscaped. From the heights students view the broad, inspiring expanses of the Kaw and Wakarusa valleys. More than 50 buildings, of classic design, with others to be erected, provide classrooms and laboratories, living quarters and recreational areas for students.

On the campus is the Memorial Stadium, home of the "Jayhawkers" football team, and site of the Kansas Relays each year. Through its vast expanse, seating 38,000, resounds the famous K.U. college yell, "Rock chalk, Jayhawk", rallying cry of K.U. alumni the world over. In basketball, K.U. stands right at the top nationally, having won 18 championships in recent years.

The School of Medicine is located in Kansas City and is one of the Midwest's finest medical centers. In addition to medical training it provides courses for nurses and technicians. Its nine buildings cover 15 acres and two other buildings occupy a campus nearby.
