$W_{\text {hen, in }}$ 1864, Nevada became a State, provision was made in its constitution for a
university universty. At that time only one other state provided for a state university in its consti-
tution. The University first opened its doors in Elko in 1874 but was removed to Reno in 1886.

From an enrollment of seven students in 1874 when instruction was started on a pre. paratory level, the University of Nevada to. day embraces the College of Arts and Science, School of Education, College of Enginering, School of Mines, and the College of Agriculture, and has an enrollment of over 1,800 students.
The Sierra Nevada Mountains, crowned by snow-capped Mount Rose which rises to an elevation of 10,800 feet, tower above the desert ranges stretch away into the distance in other directions. The campus itself, consisting of more than eighty-six acres, harmonizes with its setting. It is built around a turfed quad. rangle, at the northern end of which stands the famous statue of John W. Mackay, Comstock pioneer, wrought in bronze by Gut zon. Borglum. West of the quadrangle, Man. zanita Lake mirrors the red-brick buildings and green lawns, bordered by a variety of trees, shrubs and flowers. The elevation of Reno, 4,500 feet, makes for an equable year round climate, combining the coolness of the mountains and the dryness of the desert.
