



The University of Oregon was established through an act of the Oregon State Legislature in 1872. The institution was located at Eugene after a delegation of citizens of that city appeared before the Legislature and offered to purchase a site and erect a \$50,000.00 building for the institution. With funds raised by public subscription, the building was begun in 1873. After overcoming heartbreaking delays and difficulties, the building was finally completed and accepted by the State in July 1876. The University's first session opened in October of that year.

The University of Oregon now has an enrollment of over 6,000 students and occupies twenty-six substantial and beautiful buildings on a 130-acre campus in the eastern part of Eugene. The Medical and Dental Schools are located in Portland. Present plans call for greatly expanding the physical facilities of the University, part of the funds for which have been provided by the State.

In addition to the College of Liberal Arts, which is the central core of the program of the University, there are the professional schools as follows: School of Architecture and Allied Arts, School of Business Administration, Dental School, School of Education, School of Journalism, School of Law, Medical School, School of Music, and School of Physical Education.

A member of the Pacific Coast Conference, Oregon ranks high in athletic competition, having sent football teams to the Rose Bowl, and in 1939 produced the national championship basketball team.
