addition to the College of Liberal Arts, which is the central core of the program of the University, there are the professional schools as follows: School of Architecture and Allied Arts, School of Business Administration, Dental School, School of Education, School of Journalism, School of Law, Medical School, School of Music, and School of Physical Education.

A member of the Pacific Coast Conference Oregon ranks high in athletic competition, having sent football teams to the Rose Bowl, and in 1939 produced the national championship basketball team
