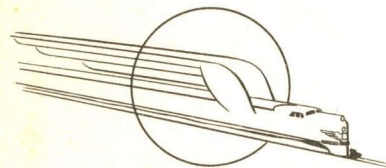
St. Louis, eighth largest city in the United States, with an estimated population in 1948 of 1,648,000 persons in the metropolitan area, was founded by a small group of French pioneers in 1764. Strategically situated, it has steadily grown in commerce, industry, and the arts to become a metropolis of world renown.

Rising westerly from the river front, St. Louis and its environs stand on rolling ground. Beyond the throbbing business hub of the city, reached by broad thoroughfares and boulevards, lie beautiful suburbs containing thousands of charming homes and a score of attractive country clubs.

The St. Louis Municipal Opera, whose summer offerings are presented in the St. Louis Municipal Theatre, Forest Park, is world-famous, and plays to a season's audience of over three-quarters of a million persons. The Civic Grand Opera Association of St. Louis; the American Theatre, and the St. Louis Symphony Orchestra provide St. Louisans with the best in cultural entertainment.

There are two nationally-known universities within the city limits—St. Louis University and Washington University—and numerous other fine institutions of learning. The recreational side of life is not neglected either, as all forms of participating and spectator sports are offered. St. Louis, likewise, is the home of two major league baseball teams.

The future growth of St. Louis, as a city of world importance, can only be conjectured. But, with its many natural advantages and its fine civic spirit, it is certain to progress far beyond the expectations of its most ardent boosters today.
