



Railroading and Doane College, located at Crete, Nebraska, go hand in hand. This is due to the fact the founder of the college, Colonel Thomas Doane, was the civil engineer that directed construction of the first railroad tunnel in the United States — the Hoosac Tunnel in Massachusetts.

Doane, oldest of Nebraska's church colleges, has had a long and distinguished history. Incorporated in 1872, it took over the Crete Academy, founded by the Congregational church the year before. And the college's history also can be traced to the old University of Nebraska, started in Fontanelle by the Congregationalists in 1858.

Standing on plush green hills overlooking the Big Blue River Valley, Doane offers its students a scenic view of the surrounding Nebraska prairies as well as a credited liberal arts education. The college normally has an enrollment of 400 students and stresses the importance of friendly relations between faculty and student.

Starting with only 13 students, Doane survived the Nebraska depressions of the '70's and '30's, not only kept alive but continued to grow. Today the college is recognized by the Association of American Universities and Colleges, the North Central Education Association and the Association of American University Women.

Merrill Hall, first building on the campus of more than 600 acres and dedicated at the 1880 commencement, still stands as the school's administration structure. It also overlooks the beautiful Blue Valley and serves to remind the present generation of students the debt they owe to those who pioneered in Christian education in the State of Nebraska.
