Typical of the vigorous and progressive spirit of the Midwest is Greater Kansas City, metropolitan center of the "Heart of America". Boasting a population of more than 725,000 persons, it is the second railroad center of the country, served by twelve trunkline railroads.

The downtown district of Kansas City bustles with activity. Towering office buildings, banks, department stores, smart shops, restaurants and theatres line the streets. Thoroughfares and boulevards in Kansas City are, for the most part, wide and well planned, providing easy access to all parts of the city. It is famous for its many fine parks, totaling 21 in number. The largest is Swope Park, whose rolling expanse of wooded hills and green valleys covers 1,386 acres, second largest city park in the country.

Just across from the Union Station, on a sightly eminence, stands Liberty Memorial, erected in 1925 to honor the memory of the service men of World War I. It is the most pretentious of many monuments, memorials and smaller pieces of statuary which add dig-

nity and charm to the city.

Possessing one of the largest livestock markets in the country, Kansas City is also a leader in the meat packing industry, and ranks second in the country as a flour milling center.

The growth of Kansas City over the years has been steadily upward in a solid and healthy manner. A list of its present industrial residents reads like the blue book of American business. And, with continuing far-sighted and aggressive leadership, coupled with Kansas City's many natural advantages, this vigorous growth will continue indefinitely.
