


ONE OF THE MANY SUBLIME VIEWS OF THE GRAND CANYON FROM THE NORTH RIM IN ARIZONA

MOUNT HOOD, OREGON VIEWED ACROSS THE FRUITFUL HOOD RIVER VALLEY






TIPSOO LAKE AND MOUNT RAINIER IN RAINIER NATIONAL PARK, WASHINGTON

JANUARY Hoover Dam, one of man's most daring engineering feats, combines symmetry with utility as it holds back a huge body of Colorado River water in beautiful Lake Mead. It serves jointly for vast power production, flood control and irrigation purposes. The waters of Lake Mead provide a recreational playground for boating, swimming and fishing for tourists and residents of near-by Boulder City and Las Vegas, Nevada.

FEBRUARY Pikes Peak, of great historic interest, is one mountain that every traveler some day hopes to see and to stand on its lofty summit, 14,109 feet. APRIL Sun Valley, Idaho is the ideal summer vacation spot. For the less active there is perfect comfort in a setting of beauty with a bracing climate of warm sunny days and cool nights. Sun Valley is quickly reached from Shoshone, Idaho on the Union Pacific Railroad.

Erosion, the tireless sculptor in nature's processes, carved Zion Canyon from the red and white sandstone cliffs of Southern Utah. Along its walls were left many beautiful rock temples. DECEMBER Sun Valley lies in the foothills of the Sawtooth Mountains in Idaho. There is an excellent terrain with long, timber-free ski runs, and a record of plenty of dry, powder snow lasting into the spring months. At this world-famed winter sports center is an alpine-type village comprising Sun Valley Lodge, Challenger Inn, several dormitory chalets, a moving picture theater, stores, post office and other buildings.
