




The King-Size "Chuck Wagon" diner.

In NEVADA the "Boom" is not confined to the Atomic Energy Test Site—the "boom" in the tourist and industrial development is statewide. Nevada is a State of "freedoms" . . . it levies few taxes on the general public; there is no State income tax on either corporations or individuals; also no inheritance tax. Southern Nevada has power from Hoover Dam and water from Lake Mead for industrial development. Last year sales from the industrial plants at Henderson, near Las Vegas, totaled 110 millions of dollars.

LAS VEGAS, too, has hit the "jack-pot." From about 8,000 population in 1940 it is now pushing 50,000 with about 100,000 in Clark County. Last

year over 7 million visitors to Las Vegas spent an estimated 162 million dollars for hotels, food, fashions, entertainment and "you know what." The downtown's "Glitter Gulch" is now topped by the 13-story Fremont Hotel; Fremont Street, from the U.P. station, is as modern as any American city with department stores, fine shops, theatres and casinos. Out on the "fantabulous" Strip where there were only four resort hotels in 1950, there are now 12 with another to open in '58. Most of the hotels are planning room additions next year to be ready for the opening of the multimillion dollar Convention Center. The Strip hotels offer entertainment unexcelled anywhere in the world.

HOOVER DAM

No charge is made for transportation from Las Vegas to Hoover Dam-Lake Mead and return to Las Vegas when issued in connection with through railroad ticket routed via Union Pacific all the way in either direction between Omaha, Nebr., Kansas City, Mo., St. Joseph, Mo., or Leavenworth, Kans., and Southern California; or Huntington, Ore., and Southern California. On all other tickets, the side trip from Las Vegas to Boulder City, Hoover Dam, Lake Mead and return to Las Vegas costs \$3.08 including tax.
