You return home from San Francisco on the streamliner "City of San Francisco" arriving in Chicago on the 21st day.

• Even the most vivid imagination could hardly conjure up anything so scenically superb as the attractions featured in this tour. It is virtually a three-in-one vacation — moderately priced, entirely all-expense, and it's completely escorted. 1st DAY • Leaving Chicago during the afternoon you cross Illinois and enter Iowa during daylight hours.

2nd DAY • Cheyenne, Wyoming in the morning — a day of train sightseeing over lands where once the buffalo roamed and cattle barons ruled — arriving Salt Lake City late evening, and then an over-night run to Cedar City, the gateway to the Utah-Arizona Wonderlands.

3rd DAY • Breakfast at El Escalante Hotel, then you are off by motor coach for Zion National Park, reached before noon. How descriptive are the names of the multi-colored peaks: Mountain of the Sun, Three Patriarchs, Altar of Sacrifice, Angel's Landing, etc. During your stay a trip will be made to the Temple of Sinawava, where stands The Great White Throne.

4th DAY • All day for hiking, horseback riding, swimming in the pool near the Lodge or just relaxing and enjoying the beautiful surroundings. There is entertainment and dancing in the evening.

5th DAY • Leave Zion after breakfast via Mt. Carmel Highway — and across the colorful Prismatic Plains and through Kaibab National Forest to Grand Canyon — in time for lunch. As you stand on its towering North Rim and look down into the vast, silent abyss, you will feel the might and majesty of nature as you have never felt it before. You can watch the sunset from the picture windows in Grand Canyon Lodge dining room.

6th DAY • Sunrise at Grand Canyon — you won't want to miss it. To watch the changing lights and shadows as the sun rises over the horizon is a sight you will never forget. The morning is open for hiking, horseback riding, or other pursuits. Exceptionally fine views of the Canyon are obtained on a 2 PM motor trip to Cape Royal and Point Imperial included as a tour feature.

7th DAY • Leaving Grand Canyon in the morning, you retrace your route through the Kaibab Forest, then via beautiful Red Canyon to Bryce Canyon, arriving in time for lunch. Bryce will fascinate you. The canyon seems filled with reproductions of every shape the human imagination can conceive. At mid-day the sunlight

produces a scene in soft pastel tones. At sunset the rocks seem to glow and the orange tones contrast vividly with the deep purple shadows. Under the enchantment of moonlight, Bryce becomes a fairyland of white gold minarets and spires, unearthly in its splendor. An afternoon motor trip to Rainbow Point, stopping at principal vantage points along the rim, is scheduled. Entertainment is provided in the evening.

8th DAY • Sunrise at Bryce is an inspiring sight. Today you will have time for a trip into its depths afoot or on horseback.

9th DAY • You leave Bryce in mid-afternoon, travel through Dixie National Forest, pause for a view of colorful Cedar Breaks, and have dinner at the lodge. Then Cedar City, where you entrain for Salt Lake City.

10th DAY • Hotel Utah for breakfast and luncheon; a full day of sightseeing including Saltair Beach, historic Salt Lake City, noon organ recital in the Tabernacle and tour of Temple Grounds. Afternoon trip to Utah Copper Mine, terminating at the D. & R. G. W. RR Station for departure at 5:30 PM.

11th DAY • Denver — a motor trip of Denver's Mountain Parks, Park of Red Rocks and Central City, early-day gold mining town, where you visit the Opera House and lunch at the famous Teller House.

As you journey homeward on the streamliner, "City of Denver," you'll relive the delightful experiences while visiting three of America's most colorful and spectacular National Parks, Salt Lake City and Denver — memories you will always cherish.

12th DAY • Breakfast — then Chicago and fond farewells as a perfect vacation comes to an end.

• The YTZ Tour is difficult to equal for variety and colorful scenic splendor — truly it is a "5-in-1" vacation.

In two weeks' time you visit five national parks — Grand Teton, Yellowstone, Zion, Grand Canyon and Bryce Canyon. Included too are Cedar Breaks National Monument, Salt Lake City, Denver and Central City, Colorado. All of these add up to a vacation that's well-nigh unbeatable.

The "YTZ" is highly recommended — it includes so much and the all-inclusive cost is moderate. Here's the story —

1st DAY • Leave Chicago during the afternoon.

2nd DAY • En route through Wyoming and Idaho.

3rd DAY • Arrive Victor, Idaho at 7:15 AM. Breakfast at Timberline Cafe — then a motor tour you'll always remember — across Teton Pass into the valley known as Jackson Hole, important cross-roads of the "Fur Trade Era" in the early 1800's, later notorious as an outlaw hideaway. Stopping at points of interest including the Chapel of the Transfiguration, you arrive at the new Jackson Lake Lodge, near Moran, at noon, where comfortably furnished rooms with bath are provided in guest-lodges. Inspiring views of the Teton from the lodge and on your motor trip through Jackson Hole.

4th DAY • After luncheon you will motor along the shores of Jackson and Yellowstone Lakes, pausing to see the Fishing Cone, Mud Geyser and other sights en route to Artist Point. Here you get your first view of the beautiful Canyon of the Yellowstone River and the great Lower Falls. Then, on to the Grand Canyon Hotel and one night's lodging. Dancing and other entertainment in the spacious lounge while away the evening hours.

5th DAY • Early morning leave by motor via Dunraven Pass and Tower Fall to Mammoth Hot Springs, reached in time for luncheon. Time to view the vari-tinted terraces and visit the National Park Museum before leaving for Old Faithful Inn — your headquarters that night. On the way to Old Faithful Inn your trip is via Apollinaris Spring, Obsidian Cliff, Norris and Gibbon Canyon Geyser Basins, with stops at principal attractions en route.

6th DAY • You will have almost a full day at Old Faithful to watch the regular eruptions of Old Faithful Geyser and to enjoy the other attractions and activities this area affords. At 4:00 PM you leave for West Yellowstone. Dinner, then board the train for the overnight ride to Salt Lake City and to Lund, Utah.

7th DAY • Buses meet the train at Lund for the drive to Zion National Park — arrive in time for dinner. Comfortable cabins with private showers are provided on your trip through the Southern Utah and Arizona Wonderlands.

8th DAY • Away after breakfast for a trip to the Temple of Sinawava to view the Great White Throne and the other magnificent monoliths that form Zion Canyon — then motor over the Mt. Carmel Highway through Kanab and the Kaibab Forest for Grand Canyon, reached in time for luncheon. You'll be thrilled with the immensity and grandeur of this world wonder.

9th DAY • Morning free to explore — afoot, or on horseback, this masterpiece of nature's handiwork. After luncheon, a motor trip to Cape Royal and Point Imperial for exceptionally fine views of the Canyon.

10th DAY • Leaving after breakfast, retrace your route through the Kaibab Forest — later through Red Canyon to Bryce Canyon — beautiful and enchanting. Bryce Rim Trip to Rainbow Point, scheduled for 3:00 PM, includes stops at many vantage points.

11th DAY • Perhaps a morning trail trip into the Canyon — luncheon — in midafternoon leave for Cedar City and your train, stopping en route for a delicious dinner at Cedar Breaks Lodge.

12th DAY • Salt Lake City — transfer to the Hotel Utah for breakfast. Motor to Saltair Beach, then to points of historic interest — return for the organ recital in Mormon Tabernacle and lunch at the Utah. Later a motor trip to world-famous Utah Copper Mine, terminating at D. & R. G. W. RR station for departure at 5:30 PM.

13th DAY • Breakfast on the train before arriving at Denver. Now follows an interesting motor trip, seeing Denver, Park of Red Rocks then through Denver's Mountain Parks to Black Hawk and Central City, early day gold-mining towns. Many reminders of these activities are still evident. Here a tour of the famous Opera House, luncheon at the Teller House, then back to Denver for 3:30 PM departure on the "City of Denver" streamliner.

14th DAY • Arrival in Chicago at 8:45 AM brings to an end a glorious vacation, memories of which you will always cherish.

June 15 through August 24.**

• This tour offers a vacation combination difficult to equal for scenic thrills and variety. In addition to the Utah-Arizona Wonderlands, the tour includes a night and day at Las Vegas, Nevada, plus an overnight stop at Colorado Springs, Colorado with a day of sightseeing in Salt Lake City and Denver as well. And you "do" three famous National Parks and visit the other attractions in less than two weeks. A brief description follows:

1st DAY • Leaving Chicago early in the morning on "The Challenger" streamliner, you will enjoy meeting your congenial fellow-travelers on this journey to adventure as you cross the states of Illinois and Iowa.

2nd DAY • During the night you pass through Nebraska and Wyoming. Mid-morning finds you in Salt Lake City, Utah, and from your car window you view the picturesque scenery of Utah. Arrival at Las Vegas is at 3:55 PM, where you will detain and walk a short distance to the Hotel Fremont, your headquarters, located in the heart of downtown Las Vegas. Dinner at the Fremont is included, however you may prefer to have dinner and see a floor show at one of the noted hotels along the "Strip." You'll want to leave part of the evening free to visit some of the casinos and other attractions for which Las Vegas is famous.

3rd DAY • After breakfast an interesting motor trip takes you to Hoover Dam and Lake Mead with luncheon at Lake Mead Lodge. Dinner at the hotel — then board your train for the overnight trip to Cedar City, Utah for a five day trip through the Utah-Arizona Wonderlands. (A Pullman berth is provided for the overnight trip to Cedar City).

4th DAY • First stop is Zion National Park. After lunch a drive to the Temple of Sinawava to view the radiantly colored monoliths that form Zion Canyon. Evening entertainment in the lodge.

5th DAY • Breakfast — then a drive of breath-taking beauty over Mt. Carmel Highway, across the Prismatic Plains and through Kaibab Forest to Grand Canyon — arriving in time for luncheon. Entertainment and dancing in the evening.

6th DAY • All day to enjoy the grandeur of Grand Canyon. Perhaps you'll get up early to see the sunrise; join a Ranger guided hike; or just relax and enjoy the views from the Lodge Terrace or Lounge. A sightseeing motor trip to Cape Royal and Point Imperial in the afternoon is included.

7th DAY • A morning motor trip via Red Canyon takes you to Bryce Canyon National Park in time for luncheon. After luncheon you motor along the rim to Rainbow Point stopping at several

vantage points en route. Again you feel the inadequacy of words to describe the weirdly etched formations and brilliant coloring of this gigantic "bowl of jewels." Truly a region of enchantment.

8th DAY • You leave Bryce Canyon in mid-afternoon, journey through Dixie National Forest, stop for a look-see at Cedar Breaks National Monument and dinner at the Lodge, then on to Cedar City and your waiting train.

9th DAY • Headquarters, Salt Lake City's Hotel Utah. An interesting day — Saltair Beach, the Tabernacle organ recital, a tour of the Temple grounds and the city. Luncheon at Hotel Utah, then a visit to the Utah Copper Mine, before leaving over the Denver & Rio Grande Western Railroad to Colorado Springs, passing through magnificent scenery and the famous Royal Gorge in the morning.

10th DAY • A motor trip to Pikes Peak and the Garden of the Gods on arrival at Colorado Springs terminates at the Antlers Hotel, headquarters that night. A Chuck Wagon dinner will be served on the hotel grounds.

11th DAY • Breakfast at the hotel — then by train to Denver where you will take a scenic sightseeing tour of Denver. Luncheon, Cosmopolitan Hotel — then depart at 3:30 PM on the streamliner "City of Denver" to Chicago.
