**FIRST PAGE** The Columbia River Gorge is one of many thrilling scenes viewed from the Astra Domes on the Domeliner "City of Portland," the finest and fastest train between Chicago and Portland. It is the only train between the Pacific Northwest and Chicago featuring three types of Astra Domes: Dome Diner, Dome Lounge Car and Dome Coach—plus a beautiful Pullman Redwood Lounge Car.

1/10 second, F16, Daylight Color Film, 4x5 Graphic View Camera, 4 inch Wide Field Ektar Lens—Bounce Flash Fill.

**JANUARY** Just 125 miles south of San Francisco, on the world-famous Monterey Peninsula, is beautiful Pebble Beach golf course where the annual "Bing Crosby Tournament" is held each January. Also on the peninsula are historic Monterey, California's first Capital, and picturesque Carmel-by-the-Sea noted for its art colony.

**FEBRUARY** Gigantic Hoover Dam, about 29 miles from Las Vegas, Nevada, is one of the great engineering feats of our time. Extending across the Colorado River between Nevada and Arizona, it backs up the Colorado River to form Lake Mead. The Dam and Lake Mead National Recreation Area now attract over three million visitors each year. Visitors may take the Guided Tour of the Dam and powerhouse. Las Vegas, on the main line of the Union Pacific, with its 'round-the-clock entertainment in casinos and resort hotels, is famed as the "Entertainment Capital of the World."

**MARCH** "The Grottos" is one of many fantastic and colorful formations to be seen in Bryce Canyon National Park, Utah. From Bryce Canyon Lodge center, near the rim, you may visit all of this fairyland either by easy foot trails with a National Park Service Ranger Guide, or by horseback with cowboy guide. Bryce Canyon has been well-named as "Nature's Art Gallery."

1/10 second, F32, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 12 inch Commercial Ektar Lens.

**APRIL** This view of Glacier Creek, with Hallett Peak in the distance, is just one of many thrilling views waiting you in Rocky Mountain National Park, Colorado. Colorado's "Mountain Playgrounds" have more mountain peaks towering over 14,000 feet than any state, except Alaska. Denver, the mile-high Capital of Colorado, is the gateway to this National Park. Denver is served by Union Pacific transcontinental Domeliners and Streamliners from Chicago and St. Louis as well as from the Pacific Coast.

**MAY** The West Rim Trail in Zion National Park, Utah, leads to such views as this of Angels Landing, on the right, and the Great White Throne, in the center. The Virgin River, and erosion, carved Zion Canyon from the red and white sandstone cliffs of Southern Utah. Zion Lodge is the first stop on the popular motor-bus circle tours which include Zion, Bryce and Grand Canyon National Parks, Cedar Breaks and Kaibab Forest. Nearby Cedar City, Utah, is the Union Pacific rail gateway.

1/10 second, F20, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 10 inch Wide Field Ektar Lens.

**JUNE** Many families have found their "Shangri La" for summer vacations in Sun Valley, Idaho. Nestled in the Sawtooth Mountains, at an elevation of 6,000 feet, it is pollen free and offers a healthful and relaxing climate. Heading its variety of sports, to suit every member of the family, is skating on the year 'round Olympic size outdoor rink. There is a supervised playground for children, and baby sitters are available so parents are free to fully enjoy their vacation desires. Evening music, dancing or motion picture theater round out the vacation day. Sun Valley is owned and operated by the Union Pacific Railroad.

1/10 second, F22, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 10 inch Wide Field Ektar Lens.

**JULY** In Grand Teton National Park, western Wyoming, just south of Yellowstone, you will see "Mountains that look just like mountains ought to look" . . . just as in this view of the Snake River with Jackson Lake and the Teton range. This is part of the world-famed "Jackson Hole Country." In addition to many Dude Ranches, a variety of accommodations are available at Jenny Lake Lodge, at the majestic new Jackson Lake Lodge, or at Colter Bay, the newest facility of Grand Teton Lodge Company. Union Pacific gateways at Victor, Idaho, or West Yellowstone, Montana, enable you to include Grand Teton and Yellowstone National Parks in one tour.

1/5 second, F28, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 14 inch Commercial Ektar Lens.

**AUGUST** At Bright Angel Point, near Grand Canyon Lodge, on the North Rim, one looks across the thirteen-mile wide chasm of the Grand Canyon of the Colorado. Similar views may be had from the Lounge or Dining Room of Union Pacific Lodge which is surrounded on all other sides by the primeval Kaibab National Forest. The Lodge is the second stop on comfortable motor-bus tours, which also include Zion and Bryce Canyon, from Cedar City, Utah, the Union Pacific gateway to the Parks.

1/5 second, F28, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 10 inch Wide Field Ektar Lens.

**SEPTEMBER** The famous Mormon Temple (Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints) and Tabernacle are seen in this portion of Temple Square in historic Salt Lake City. During the summer season free organ recitals are given daily in the Tabernacle, famed for its acoustical perfection. A popular tourist attraction is the Great Salt Lake where one may experience a "non-sink" swim. Salt Lake City, on the main line of the Union Pacific Railroad, is the hub of the vast scenic Intermountain Empire, and an important trade center.

1/10 second, F20, Daylight Color Film, 8x10 View Camera, 10 inch Wide Field Ektar Lens.

**OCTOBER** Mount Hood, Oregon, in the Cascade Range of the Pacific Northwest, is snow-clad the year 'round. At the base of this 11,245-foot peak is Timberline Lodge where skiers or mountain climbers gather any season of the year for their favorite sport. Fall, as you can see, is a most colorful time to visit Mt. Hood. It is conveniently reached from Portland, Oregon, Pacific Northwest terminal for Union Pacific's Domeliner "City of Portland."
