



The business district of San Francisco is a compact and accessible area of stately public buildings and banking institutions, hotels, apartment houses, fine department stores, smart style shops and other business establishments.

The towered Ferry Building, famous the world over, stands at the foot of Market Street, which runs diagonally southwest to Twin Peaks and divides the city in half. Along this broad traffic artery is "transportation row," including newly located Union Pacific ticket office at Fremont and Market Streets, the Sheraton-Palace Hotel, banks, big department stores and movie theatre "row." Near the upper end just off Market Street is the palatial Civic Center with municipal and Federal buildings designed in Italian Renaissance style.

In certain quarters of San Francisco there is more than a suggestion of foreign cities. At one point you may be reminded of Paris, and not far away is world-famous Chinatown, with strange pagoda-like buildings along its streets and alleys. Oriental costume mingles with American, and quaint Chinese patter may be heard on all sides. The fishing fleet, which ties up at Fisherman's Wharf, is largely manned by descendants of the early Italian fishermen of the city. There is hardly a land on the face of the earth that is not well represented in San Francisco's cosmopolitan population.

Perhaps it is this fusing of so many peoples that contributes to the strength and vigor of San Francisco and adds so much to its charm. Truly, it is one of the great cities of the world.
