Visitors to Los Angeles should not miss seeing the famous Sunken Gardens in Exposition Park covering an area of seven acres. There are 144 varieties of roses represented in the 15,000 bushes growing there. Marble statuettes and graceful fountains enhance the beauty of the place.

Just across Exposition Boulevard rise the stately buildings of the University of Southern California, embracing a 50-acre campus. The University, founded in 1876, today has an enrollment of approximately

17,000 students.

In Exposition Park, also, is the State Exposition Building, housing a permanent exhibition of the resources and industries of California, as well as the Los Angeles County Museum of History, Science and

Here, too, is the vast Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum, seating 105,000 persons, scene of the Tenth International Olympiad in 1932. At the present time it is used for pageants and other civic gatherings, and is also the site of professional and collegiate football games.
