



**T**he Grand Canyon of Yellowstone, as seen from either Artist Point or Inspiration Point, is one of the truly great wonders of the West. It is hard to conceive of such breath-taking beauty. Once you have gazed into its jagged depths, alive with color, you will never forget it.

From Artist Point your gaze follows the curve of the canyon to where, in the distance, may be seen the silvery sheet of the Lower Fall plummeting 308 feet downward to the green, serpentine Yellowstone River.

One of the hundreds of other natural wonders in Yellowstone is Old Faithful, the famous geyser. Every 60 to 80 minutes an immense column of hissing, boiling water soars gracefully to a height of 120 feet or more. Other geysers will intrigue you as will the bubbling paint pots, Firehole and Madison Rivers, Yellowstone Lake, and, of course, the Yellowstone bears and other wild life that inhabit the park.

The Yellowstone Park and Transportation Company maintains excellent hotels, lodges and cabin accommodations at Old Faithful, Lake, Canyon Village and Mammoth, and provides the bus service for Yellowstone Park tours.

Thousands of Union Pacific travelers visit Yellowstone and near-by Grand Teton National Park annually as complete vacations, but they can also be seen on a short side-trip on your way to or from the Pacific Northwest. You may enter the West entrance from Ashton, Idaho, gateway and depart via Victor, Idaho, or vice versa . . . the most popular gateways to these national parks.
