


 $T_{\rm o}$ the summer vacationist and outdoor sports enthusiast, Sun Valley, Idaho, is an ideal vacation resort. Many popular sports may be enjoyed: a new 18-hole golf course "air-conditioned" by nature, horseback riding, hiking, fishing, bicycling, chair-lift rides up Mt. Baldy (in the Sawtooth National Forest), skeet and trap shooting, bowling, tennis and others. The large Olympic-size ice rink is the scene of ice carnivals during July and August, and skating instructors train advanced skaters as well as beginners from June 4 over Labor Day. There are two outdoor swimming pools. Pack trips and big game hunting are available in season in the primitive mountain regions. "Drive Yourself Auto Service" is available. If you only wish to loaf and relax, you'll enjoy a bracing climate of warm sunny days and cool nights at an altitude of 6,000 feet. In winter there is skiing, sleigh riding, ice skating and warm water swimming.

In all seasons music, dancing and fun are enjoyed during the evening hours, including first-run movies in the Opera House.

Popular times for conventions and sales groups are the months of May, June and September through October 15. Small sales groups interested in meeting during the ski season may be accommodated in January or March.


