

Largest and best known of our National Parks is Yellowstone. Much of it is in Northwest Wyoming, but it embraces small areas in Idaho and Montana. Most famous and most popular of its startling phenomena are the geysers. Old Faithful, with great regularity, about every 60 to 80 minutes, throws its shaft of steam and boiling hot water to a great height, sometimes as much as 150 feet, always delighting its spectators.

Other great scenic features of the Park include Yellowstone Lake, several beautiful mountain ranges, many colorful pools and springs, the Mammoth Hot Springs, a petrified forest, and the color-splashed Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River with a waterfall at its head that leaps more than 300 feet into the canyon.

Yellowstone is also a wild life sanctuary and the playful bears to be found there are always popular with visitors.
