CONEFLOWER: Lowish slender perennial with long stalked yellowish or brownish purple heads, coneshaped, yellow center, divided leaves. May-September.

DAISIES: Most common of the large multicolored Daisy family is the Aspen Daisy. Handsome erect leafy plant with flat-topped clusters of pinklavender flowers. June-August.
