**CONEFLOWER:** Lowish slender perennial with long stalked yellowish or brownish purple heads, cone-shaped, yellow center, divided leaves. May-September.

**DAISIES:** Most common of the large multi-colored Daisy family is the Aspen Daisy. Handsome erect leafy plant with flat-topped clusters of pink-lavender flowers. June-August.
