At the scene, the footing was icy and treacherous and Roger had to be careful where he stepped because of a 25-foot drop in front of him.



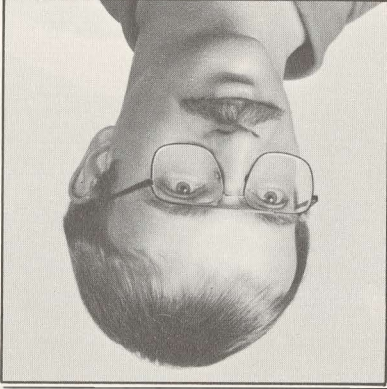
February

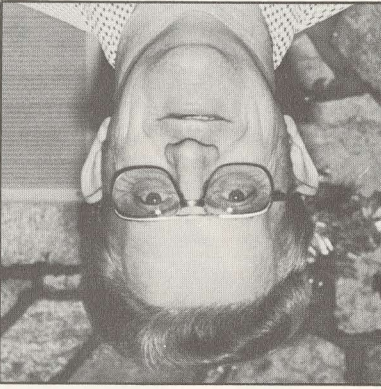
March

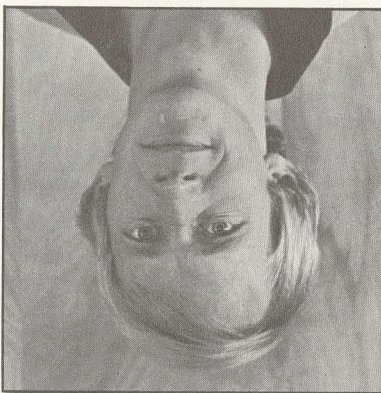
April

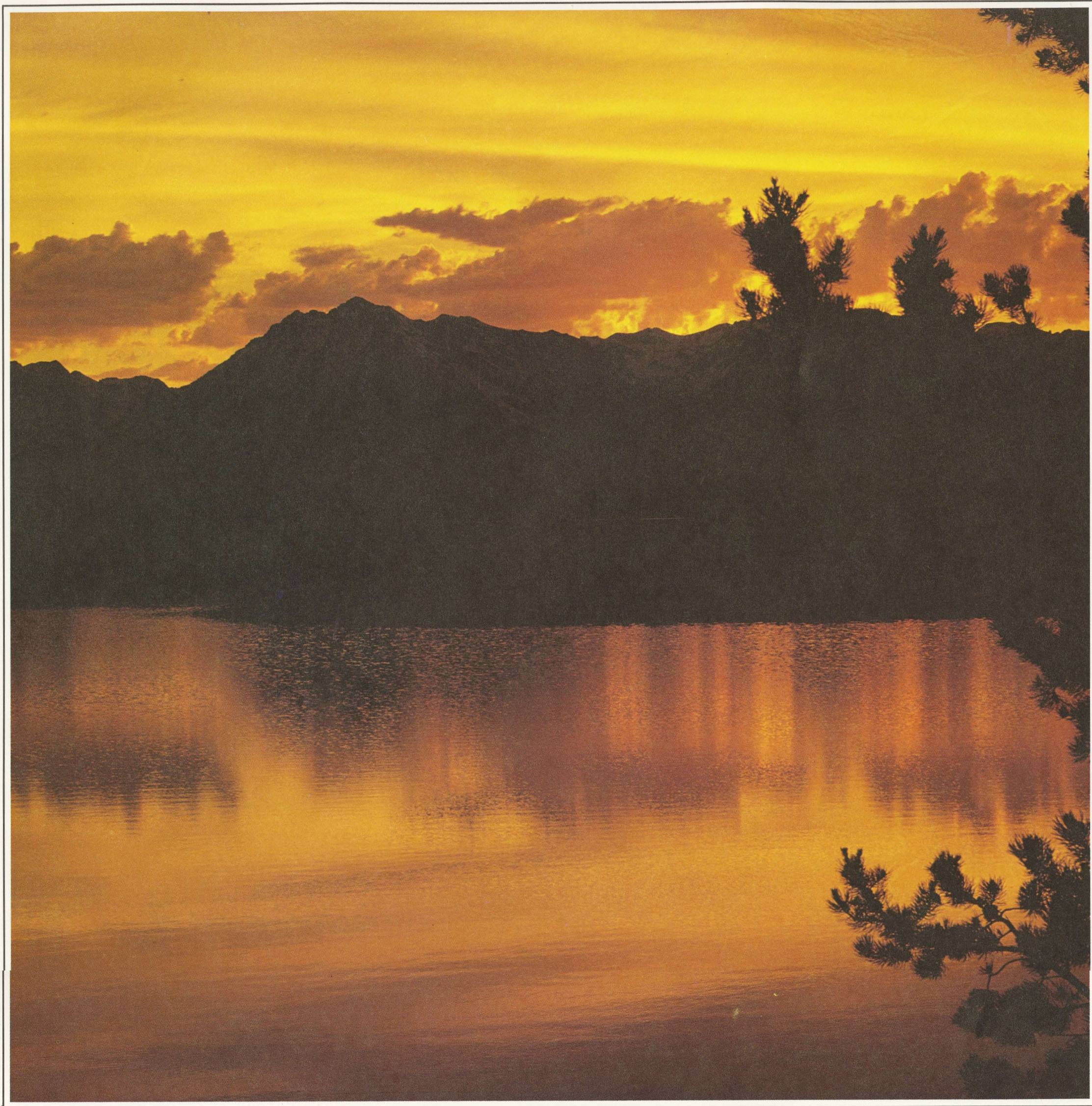

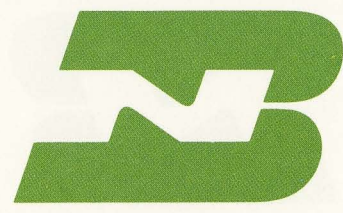

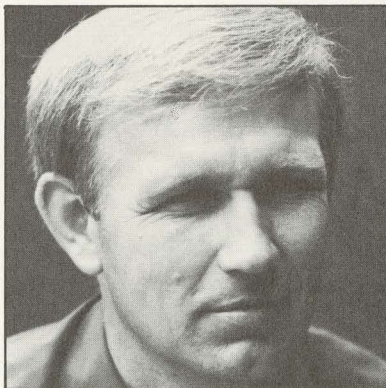

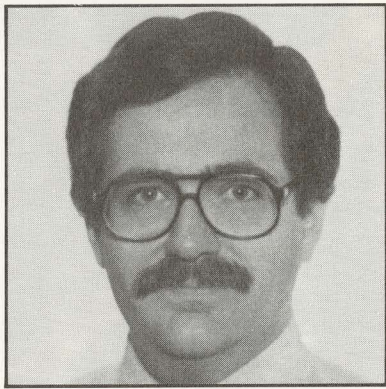

Woodbury, Minnesota

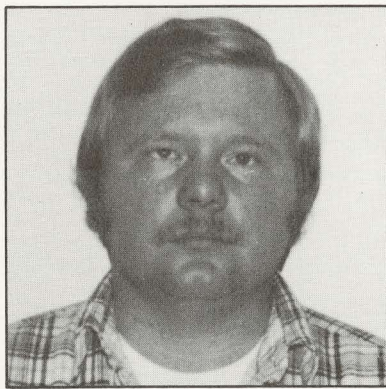

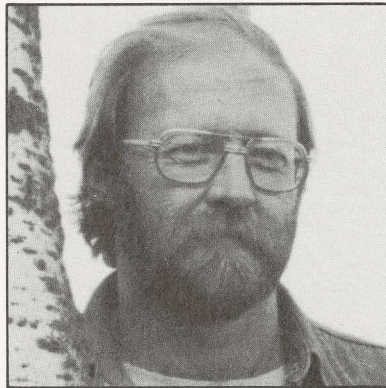
