The naming of railroad cars, ordinarily a pointless process of selection, here achieves direct significance, for each glistening, silvery "chariot" glorifies in stainless steel the legendary virtues of some classic deity. Here is exemplified the power and wisdom of Jupiter plus the supernal, silent speed of Zephyrus and Pegasus — the metallurgical genius of Vulcan, master artisan — the beauty and poetic rhythm of Venus and Apollo — the handicraft of Minerva.
