**B. & O. Passenger Units Upgraded**—Eleven 201-A 1,800 H.P. units, in service on the Baltimore & Ohio since 1937-38, were remanufactured by Electro-Motive and upgraded to 2,000 H.P. These modernized 17-year-old General Motors locomotives have gone back into the passenger pool handling regular runs with the same efficiency as newer models. Factory rebuilding of old Diesels prevents obsolescence of capital equipment—and the upgrading pays a substantial return on investment.
